2022 Proposed Change to the MA UPMA Bylaws #3

Convention Year: 2022	Article: V – Election of Officers, Paragraph 3

Description: The amendment sets forth requirements for an officer nomination from the floor even if the nominee is not present at the state convention. Sections will be added to align with suggested format from Robert's Rules of Order and the national bylaws.

Rationale: Candidates wishing to run for an officer position may be unable to attend the state convention due to extenuating circumstances but still want to be considered for election. Paragraphs titled Sections to align with suggested format from Robert's Rules of Order and the national bylaws.

To amend Bylaws Article V by striking the language "provided the nominee is present during the nomination and election" and inserting the language "If the nominee is not present at the state convention to accept the nomination, they must have submitted a letter to the President to be read that includes a brief reason for non-attendance and acceptance of the nomination.
