

SCAVENGER HUNT



There's only one catch to this scavenger hunt. HAVE FUN! Your dog will learn faster while you both will have a great experience.

Remember:

1. **GO SLOW!** Everything must be accomplished at your dog's pace. If your dog is nervous, backing away, or trying to hide. Take it even slower.
2. **USE DISTANCE!** Stay away from things until your dog is comfortable. If your dog is scared from something 5 feet away, it's likely your dog will be terrified being 1 foot. Allow your dog to get comfortable from a safe distance first, then move closer as your dog relaxes.
3. **USE REWARDS!** Mere exposure to things is not enough. Making good associations with "The New" High-value treats/toys makes a good experience. If your dog stops eating treats or playing with their favorite toy. That is a sure sign of stress. Your clue to back off and try it another time.
