



Insider's Tour of *Bordeaux & Dordogne, France* with Philippe & Lisa Boët

June 2 - 13, 2026: Join us for a 12-day cultural, culinary, and wine exploration of France's Southwest. Known for prestigious wine châteaux, picturesque villages and exquisite cuisine, the regions of Bordeaux and Dordogne are home to prehistoric glacier beds and ancient troglodyte structures.

After meeting in Paris our first night, we'll travel to St. Emilion, a UNESCO world heritage site, on Bordeaux's Right Bank. Next, onward to Trémolat in Dordogne, our home base for five days. After our stay in Perigord, we return to Bordeaux's wine country and spend four nights at an elegant five-star château hotel in St. Estèphe. After our final day in Bordeaux city, we'll travel back to Paris via train to spend our last night and enjoy dinner in St. Germain des Près.

Day trips in Dordogne include: Sarlat on market day, a truffle visit, an artisanal cheese farm visit, explorations of Bastide villages Domme and Rocamadour, a boat ride on the Dordogne River, and a Lascaux cave tour. In Bordeaux, our private tours of wine châteaux and tastings are hosted by Bordeaux wine expert Martine Mandé. We'll travel to Sauternes, Pessac-Leognan, St. Estèphe, St. Julien, Margaux, and more. While exploring mythic wineries, producers of Great Classified Wines, we'll pamper your palate with sophisticated meals in wine châteaux, local bistros and an artful Michelin-starred dinner, to round out our gourmet adventures.
