Sample Project Experience

Emerging Trends, Role of Changing Consumer Preference and Mobility (Washington, DC)

Mr. Schiffer was an invited panelist at a TRB Emerging Trends Symposium, held in August 2018 at TRB's Washington, DC office. The areas of new mobility discussed were transportation network companies, connected vehicles, shared mobility, and autonomous vehicles. There was much debate about key demographics driving these changes and the impact of these modes on transit ridership and auto traffic.

Travel Demand Modeling of Olympus Sports Development (Clermont, Florida)

Mr. Schiffer is providing travel demand modeling services for the proposed Olympus Sports and Entertainment development, to be located along US 27 in Lake County, just south of Clermont. He is responsible for simulating project traffic for the year 2025 using the Central Florida Regional Planning Model (CFRPM) maintained by the Florida Department of Transportation District 5 Planning Office.

Polk Transportation Planning Organization On-Call Planning Services (Bartow, Florida)

Mr. Schiffer previously managed three task work orders for the Polk County Transportation Planning Organization to identify and evaluate alternative approaches to collecting origin/destination (O/D) trip data for different study areas, trip purposes and vehicle types. Missouri DOT Benefit/Cost Analysis of I-70 Rocheport Bridge (Rocheport, Missouri)

A benefit/cost analysis was conducted, relying in part on changes to vehicle-miles traveled (VMT), estimated through Mr. Schiffer's application of a nationwide travel demand model.

Walton County Mobility Plan (Santa Rosa Beach, Florida)

FuturePlan Consulting will serve as subconsultant on a study to prepare a mobility plan and mobility fee for fast growing Walton County in Northwest Florida. Mr. Schiffer will lead travel demand and travel behavior analysis using big data on trip O/D patterns in combination with the area's regional travel model.
