Woman of the Year Mayor Jessica Day



Mayor Jessica Day grew up in Knightdale, NC and has really seen it grow from a small community to one of the fastest growing cities in North Carolina.

She holds a Bachelor of Business Administration from the University of North Carolina at Greensboro. Upon graduation, she started her career with Syngenta Crop Protection in Greensboro, NC, as the charter member of their 2-year Supply Chain Leadership Development Program. She was able to rotate through the different areas of the supply chain including the planning, purchasing, plant operations, and sales departments. She, then, continued in the Agro-Chemical business with BASF Chemical Company. Since the start of her career, she has had the opportunity to gain additional experience in real estate sales, insurance sales, and financial education.

Mayor Day has always had a passion to give back to her community and to help others improve their quality of life. In 2017, Jessica became the first African American female to be elected to the Knightdale Town Council, and in 2019, she became Mayor Pro Tem. In January 2021, Jessica was the unanimous choice to fill the position vacated by the resignation of Representative James Roberson, making Day the first African American female to hold the seat as Mayor for the Town of Knightdale. In November 2021, she was re-elected by an overwhelming majority.

Let us delve a little bit more into exactly who Mayor Day is as a person. As you know, we are living in a time of social and political unrest and injustice. Realizing this, Mayor Day has stepped up to the plate to do her part in positively impacting our community. She has stepped up to do her part to help our people, and to make sure that we are well-represented, in a town where the Black community has largely been underrepresented. Most recently, Mayor Day served as facilitator for the Knightdale Police Department's Community Policing Forum, and she has served as a liaison to the Public Safety Advisory Board. Additionally, Mayor Day serves on the Board of Directors for Passage Home, Inc.

In addition to serving in the abovementioned capacities, Mayor Day serves on the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board and Knightdale Chamber of Commerce. She also is on the Board of Delegates for the Triangle J Council of Governments, which is one of the 17 regional North Carolina Councils of Governments established by the North Carolina General Assembly for the purpose of regional planning and administration. As a member of the Knightdale Rotary Club, Mayor Day focuses on addressing food insecurity and promoting community development and truly believe in "service above self." Above all, though, she is a proud member of World Overcomers Christian Church.

Her commitment to the community by embracing economic development, supporting small business, and realizing education opportunities for all citizens are key elements that result in a more vibrant and thriving community. Likewise, Senator Sarah Crawford believes that "Knightdale is so fortunate to have Jessica Day serving as Mayor. "Jessica is a proven leader, who is passionate about serving the town and its residents." In her free time, Mayor Day enjoys a good dance class like Zumba or a chance to relax doing yoga or reading a good book.

She is missionary at heart and works diligently with Lott Carey Foreign Mission where she serves as operational contact for disaster services.

Eva's spirit for service for humanity connected her with the American Red Cross. She has been a volunteer over six years were she primary serves as Disaster Pre-Assignment Health Question specialist and Disaster Health Services Service Associate.

Amica of the Year Cathryn "Dawn" Williams




