Jack Mercer Trophy Criteria

1. The recipient of the award must be a paid member of **QCAGC**.
2. The Jack Mercer Trophy will be awarded to recognize the winner for their shooting skill, dedication to, support of the club, and the desire to compete in the sport of Air Gun shooting.
3. The winner will be the one to accumulate the highest number of points in the Rifle Benchrest, Pistol Benchrest and Field Target.
4. The competition season will be during the months of January, February, March, April, October, and November.
5. Points awarded will be: five for 1st place, three for 2nd place and one for 3rd place.
6. Point standings will be recorded and emailed to all members after the last event of each month.
7. Rifle Benchrest matches will consist of two events. One event shall be two twenty-five-meter targets shot at twenty-five meters. The other event shall be two rounds of silhouettes. The Saguaro Classic will include two-cards shot at fifty yards or two-cards shot at seventy-five yards. The third event shot at the Saguaro will be eligible for JMT points. The order of events shall be determined by the Competition Committee.
8. Pistol Benchrest matches will consist of two events. They shall be two fifty-meter targets shot at ten yards and two rounds of pistol silhouettes. Pistolero de Saguaro will also consist of two fifty-meter targets shot at ten yards and two rounds of silhouettes. If a third event is added to the Pistolero de Saguaro it will be eligible for JMT points.
9. Classes for Rifle Benchrest are described in the Competition Safety Rules and Procedures.
10. Classes for Benchrest Pistol are described in the Competition Safety Rules and Procedures
11. All rifles are limited to no more than .22 caliber.
