# August 2021 Minutes Animal Companions of Las Cruces

Two alternative virtual meetings were held, the first at 2:30 pm on 16 August and the second at 5:15 pm on 19 August. Both meetings were convened by organizer Dawn Duncan via her Zoom account.

## 16 August Meeting

Notes: (\*Off topic comments are not included for brevity or to maintain focus.)

- Maybe also ask how many hours do they spend themselves on after hours emergencies for their clients. A category to add to the questions for the regional vets (along with where they currently send clients with emergencies, would they send to LC instead, average cost of emergency visit)
- Would a friendly city council member help us with a survey of citizens, as opposed to a petition? (Carol volunteered to contact asst. city manager she knows. She has already accomplished this task and has provided a list of helpful contacts—see below.)
- How about connecting with our representative who is animal friendly? Nancy volunteered to make that connection
- Do we need a central repository for our info, possibly a dedicated email account, etc.? Response: we will use <u>dawn@narrative4.com</u> (has permission from her job as an "empathy into action" project) rather than create a third email for Dawn to manage.
- One major concern that needs to be addressed at some point is the cost. Rumors have it that past clinics have died here because people could not afford to pay. We did not get to this point but will find out more via research.
- Dawn, can you send out a list of people in this task force and contact info...specifically email addresses. With permission from members, Dawn will do so Friday after the Thursday alternate meeting.
- Has anyone gathered the data as to why it didn't work? Do we have a need survey? (anecdotal from Next Door and from our own vets, can be a task for someone to tackle with finesse)

- Would it be worthwhile to connect with SCORE, which helps small businesses get off the ground?
- Cyndi Haber noted that we should think about how to become part of Las Cruces general obligation bond projects, which citizens vote on. She also noted that in a year the building that currently houses the shelter will be available since a new shelter is being built. Perhaps this could be an excellent space for the hospital.
- Cynthia Madden spoke about the shortage of vets here. Cynthia has provided initial research into the vet shortage nationwide (see supplementary attachment) and urges us to get veterinarians on board. Dawn confirmed that one is on the interest list, that she has spoken briefly with her own vet here (Dr. Tucker at Jornada), and that we have been given hours of advice now by veterinarian Dr. Kevin Dill, formerly of NM and her vet of 15 years in ND/MN border town. We do indeed plan to share our plans with our local vets and seek their input.
- Bonnie mentioned that Colorado has an excellent veterinary school and would be a great source for recruitment, and she has connections there. Dawn added Texas A& M also as a good source. We plan to create a booklet and do recruiting.
- Some general comments at end included: I think this is a great start! Happy to help get this going. I am excited to work with all of you...although I've never done anything like this. Etc.
- Dawn asked that everyone send her times of days, evenings, or weekends that they are available so we can set our next meeting. We plan to meet again mid-September as a large group and report back on progress.
