

Comparison of Like Cities





Animal Companions of Las Cruces



Animal Companions of Las Cruces Income Demographics

- Las Cruces is one of 3 cities (out of 100) of similar size nationwide without After Hours ER Vet Services within 25 miles
 - Las Cruces, NM (Median Income \$43,022)
 - Wichita Falls, TX (Median Income \$46,476)
 - Chico, CA (Median Income \$53,324)
- Income Demographics may be a barrier to overcome
 - \$63,751 is the Average Median Income of Cities with and IN TOWN option
 - 6 cities with lower median income than Las Cruces have their own IN TOWN ER Vet
 - Our population growth rate over the last 10 years was 14.10%, which is strong
 - A tale of two cities may want to look at income distribution
 - Housing starts appear to be very strong may want to gather some data on that



Locating Regional Veterinary Clinics— Dawn Duncan

Mapping and creating perimeter: ½ way points between Las Cruces and 3 cities that provide Emergency Animal Services—El Paso, Albuquerque, and Silver City. 63 towns within the radius required research/contact.

Beyond Las Cruces

- Emails were sent to eleven clinics outside of Las Cruces
- Four clinics have responded (as of 09/13/21)

Las Cruces Veterinarians

Emails were sent to seven clinics within Las Cruces
One clinic has responded (as of 09/13/21)

Beyond Las Cruces

- One clinic provides own emergency services; three refer to El Paso
- Two have less than 5 emergency referrals per week; two have 10-15 per week
- Two said cost was about \$450; two said \$1,150
- Three would send their emergencies to Las Cruces; one said "Maybe"

Beyond Las Cruces - Comments

- "The sooner the better!"
- "Having a trusted afterhours option would take the worries off our shoulders."
- "There is a need for immediate care and a facility equipped and staffed for it."
- "Recruitment of vets and staff is the hard part. Offer great incentives."

Las Cruces Veterinarians – One Clinic so far...

- Refers all emergencies to El Paso (very few)
- Might like a clinic in Las Cruces depending on the quality of care available
- Would not be willing to help with rotations (a oneperson clinic)

Las Cruces Veterinarians - Comments

- "Start with standard services and equipment."
- "It's very difficult to find and keep qualified personnel."
- "Crucial to determine ownership. Check state law to determine if it's legal for a non-DVM to own a veterinary clinic."
- "It is a huge financial undertaking to open and maintain a quality practice, especially an emergency clinic."
