Definitions

- “Graduates Unavailable for Employment” means the graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.
- “Graduates Employed in the Field” means graduates who beginning within six months after a student completes the applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose employment has been reported, and for whom the institution has documented verification of employment. For occupations for which the state requires passing an examination, the six months period begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first examination available after a student completes an applicable educational program.

STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

REFUND POLICY "STUDENTS RIGHT TO CANCEL" (CEC §94911(e)(1)(2)(3))

The School is required to maintain a fair and equitable refund policy that ensures the refund of any unearned tuition and other charges to the student.

YOU HAVE A RIGHT TO CANCEL AND OBTAIN A REFUND OF CHARGES PAID THROUGH ATTENDANCE AT THE FIRST (1st) CLASS SESSION OR THE SEVENTH (7th) DAY AFTER ENROLLMENT, WHICHEVER IS LATER.

If you have received federal student financial aid funds, you are entitled to a refund of any amount paid that were not covered by federal financial aid program funds.

If you have not toured or visited the School campus prior to enrollment, you will have an additional three (3) calendar days following the date of your tour to cancel their enrollment without penalty.

a. After the First Class Session or Seventh Day Following Enrollment Date

The School's Refund Policy entitles you to a refund of any monies paid, in accordance with the terms outlined in this policy. After the first (1st) class session or the seventh (7th) following the Enrollment Date (whichever is later), you will be charged tuition equal to the length of the course. See Section 3. You will receive a full refund of the charges less than the amount retained by the school which will not exceed \$250.00.

b. Refund Policy After Termination or Withdrawal CEC 94920(d)

The refund policy for students who have completed 60 percent or less of the period of attendance shall be a pro rata refund. To calculate the eligible refund, the Payment Period is used as the basis for determining the pro rata amount. A pro rata refund is calculated based on the number of days or hours the student attended, relative to the total number of days or hours in the current course ("Payment Period"), up to a maximum of 60%. This percentage is then applied to the total tuition, fees, and any qualifying costs.

Pro-Rata Refund Calculation Example

If a student withdraws from the program after the cancellation period, the institution will calculate a pro-rata refund based on the number of hours attended. The calculation is based on the proportion of the program completed (hours attended divided by the total number of program hours).

For example:

If a program consists of 160 total hours and the student completes 40 hours, the student has completed 25% of the program. The institution will retain the portion of tuition corresponding to the percentage of hours attended, plus the non-refundable registration fee (not to exceed \$250). The remaining balance of tuition paid will be refunded to the student within 45 days of the withdrawal date.

c. Request for Cancel or Withdraw from School

To cancel your enrollment agreement or withdraw from the institution, you must provide written notice to the School's Admissions Office. This notice can be submitted in person, by email at empiretruckingschool@gmail.com or via mail at 11479 S. East End Ave., Ontario, CA 91710. The notice must include your full name, student ID, and the date of cancellation or withdrawal.

Upon receipt of your notice, the School will process your cancellation or withdrawal request in accordance with the School's refund policy. If you are eligible for a refund, it will be calculated based on the date the notice of cancellation or withdrawal is received.
