## In honor of National Pet Parents Day (April 30), here are 10 FAQs regarding County Animal Control.

### 1. What to do if you have lost or found a dog or cat?

- File a report on [lost.petcolove.org](http://lost.petcolove.org)
- Notify Animal Control - We do accept healthy stray animals, but prioritize shelter capacity for sick, injured, and dangerous animals.
- Have the animal scanned for a microchip

### 2. Where can I look for my lost pet?

• As part of Animal Control's routine intake process, we take photographs of all incoming animals. Our database is linked with [lost.petcolove.org](http://lost.petcolove.org) where animals in our care remain viewable online until they are redeemed or transferred to another agency. The site uses facial recognition technology to scan pet profiles in our database against lost reports every two hours. Once a potential match is identified, our agency receives an alert.

Our shelters are not open to the public and require an appointment with a Humane Officer to redeem your pet.

### 3. How do I get in contact with Animal Control?

- For immediate or emergency animal control assistance, you may contact HPD Dispatch at 808.935-3311. Police dispatch will reach out to an ACO or Police Officer to respond to the call 24/7. For less urgent matters, or general information, contact the main shelter line at 808.327.3558 to speak with an ACO between the hours of 8AM-5PM. Leave a clear, detailed message with your full name, and phone number. Your message will be returned in order of importance.

### 4. Where can I go to adopt or foster an animal from Animal Control?

- Animal Control does not adopt nor foster animals direct to the public. We utilize our non-profit transfer partners both locally and on the mainland to screen homes to find potential adopters.

This process allows us to focus on the law enforcement component of animal welfare and caretaking of our residents, many of which have special needs. Our transfer partners are essential to our agency, providing an unclaimed animal an opportunity towards a positive disposition.

Animal Control covers the costs of various medical treatments including spay and neuter of transferred animals to other agencies at no cost to the rescue. This allows Animal Control a non-competing arrangement with transfer partners for pet homes, which are already limited on Big Island.

Animal Control currently works with over 15 non-profit animal rescue agencies.

5. For what situations will I be asked to provide proof of pet ownership?

- Your pet is picked up or is turned into Animal Control.
- Your pet was lost and is found by someone who is unwilling to return him/her.
- You and your significant other separate, and both of you want to keep the pet.
- Your pet is accused of causing injury to a person or animal.
- You are requesting to surrender your pet to Animal Control.




6. What ways can I provide proof of ownership to redeem my pet from Animal Control?

- Microchip registration
- Dog license registration
- Veterinarian records
- Adoption record or purchase receipt
- Identification tag - tag should have your current address and phone number.
- Photographs that are clear and show any distinguishing markings on your pet.
- Should you have shared custody or special arrangement, a notarized copy of the pet agreement showing who is responsible for the pet's care and ownership.
- Pet insurance
- Estate plans

7. Why does Animal Control require proof of ownership?

- Animals are considered property in the state of Hawaii. Therefore, we must ensure an animal goes home with its rightful legal owner. A legal owner or guardian who is unable to physically redeem their animal in person may authorize another person in their place. Your Humane Officer will assist you in this process.



8. Why does Animal Control require a redemption fee?

- Under Chapter 4 of the Hawai'i County Code, various fees are required by law and may be assigned in the return of your animal. Fees are determined by the circumstances of which your animal was impounded on. Multiple fees and a citation may be warranted, including a conditions check prior to the return of your animal.

9. What is Animal Control's medical care intake process and how will it cost me when redeeming my pet?

Animal Control charges for the cost of treatment or procedure only. There is no mark-up or profit made by the County.

- Vaccination
- Intestinal parasite treatment
- Flea and tick treatment/prevention
- Microchip
- Dog License
- Any associated veterinary fees to stabilize and /or treat your injured or sick animal
- Spay or neuter costs
- Heartworm, and FELV/FIV testing

10. How do I pay the redemption fee?

A Humane Officer will inform you of the exact amount due and schedule an appointment for pick-up or drop-off of the animal.

- Check (personal or cashier's) made to County Director of Finance
- Money Order made to County Director of Finance



### CALLS PRIORITIZED 1, 2, 3

**Priority 1:** (1 hour response time, qualifies for after-hours field response.)

**Priority 2:** (same day response, DOES NOT qualify for after-hours response.)

**Priority 3:** (same day contact with reporting party, delayed field response.)

FOR LOST / FOUND PETS & NON-EMERGENCIES

## LET'S TALK ABOUT UNDERAGE DRINKING

How do your conversations about alcohol usually begin?

Conversations about alcohol happen everyday, and a key ingredient should be “responsibility.” That is why we inspire a lifetime of conversations around alcohol responsibility. It’s not a one time thing. Since parents are the leading influence on their kids’ decision to drink or not to drink, these conversations must happen early and often, starting when your child is in elementary school, and continuing through middle school, high school, college, and beyond.

You know most kids don't drink, right?

You know you can call me if your friends are drinking, right?

Let's talk about the rules for using the family car, okay?

Check out some of these facts to share with kids, from parenting expert, family physician and National Advisory Board Member Dr. Deborah Gilboa:

Age matters: drinking underage negatively affects brain development.

Women and girls are affected even faster by alcohol because of the amount of water in their bodies.

The smaller your build, the faster alcohol will affect you, and at lower amounts.

Certain types of drinks contain a higher percentage of alcohol than others. While a standard glass of beer is taller than a standard glass of wine, they contain the same amount of alcohol.

**Why are these conversation starters important? Because when conversations around alcohol go up, underage drinking rates go down. Kids need to hear reportedly that underage drinking is illegal. And that underage drinking and drunk driving are both illegal and dangerous.**


