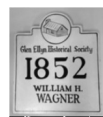

How are plaques awarded?

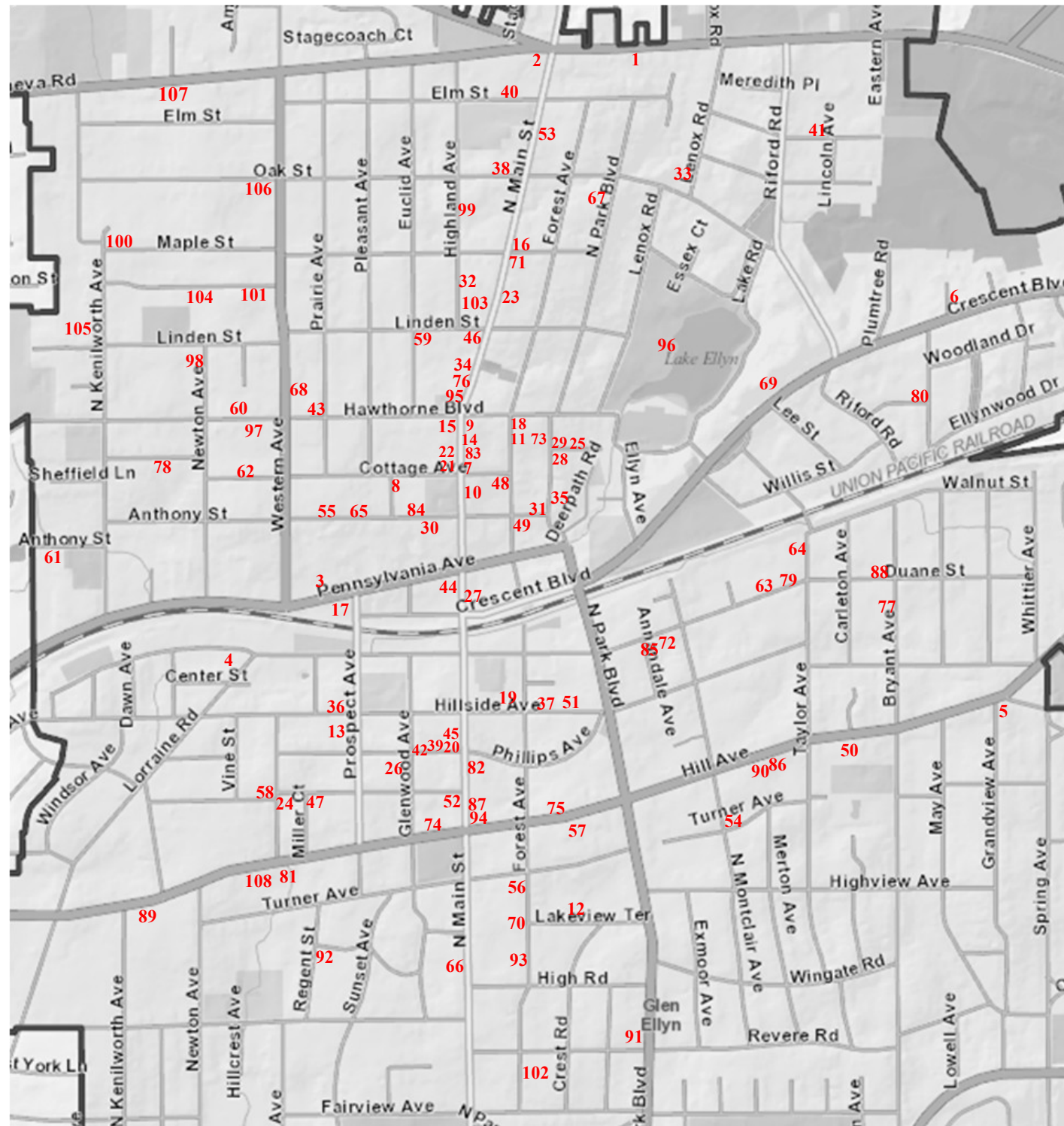
Requests for plaquing of a structure may be made in person at the History Center, by submitting a letter via USPS or by email. Include the address of the building and the name and contact information of the current owner. A contribution to the Glen Ellyn Historical Society allows volunteers to research a house or building. Tax records and inspection are used to determine if the house meets the following criteria:



- Age: Over 80 years old
- Historic Significance
- Architectural Significance
- Maintenance

If the house meets the criteria, a second contribution funds the creation of the plaque and a report with complete information on the history of the house. A short ceremony is held at the house or building to deliver the plaque. A volunteer presents the findings of the research and provides a copy for the homeowner to keep.

GEHS House Plaque Program

The House Plaque Program was established by the GEHS in 1969 to recognize houses and buildings of historical and/or architectural significance. Since then, 106 buildings have been awarded plaques; most are displayed proudly at front entrances. Many of the plaqued homes are located downtown between 549 and 592 Main Street, a National Register District.

There are many other homes in Glen Ellyn that are deserving of a plaque. Contact the Glen Ellyn Historical Society if you would like your home or building to be considered for this designation.
