^{*}Most require pets to be up to date on all vaccinations prior to surgery. Additional vaccination fees will be added if applicable. Call or visit their website for more information. Most vet clinic pricing for dog S/N varies by weight. These base estimates were given for an approx. 20-30 lbs. dog, but cost may incrementally increase with weight increase. Medications, catheter fees, lab fees, etc. are additional fees that may not be included in all base pricing, so confirm total costs upon booking appointment for the most accurate pricing.

HOMELESS ANIMAL RELIEF PROJECT

Free/minimal-cost spay/neuter for stray/feral/unsocialized homeless cats of North Mississippi. Located in Senatobia, MS, H.A.R.P. has been providing minimal cost spay/neuter surgery to cat owners unable to afford vetting costs and free/minimal cost spay/neuter for stray outdoor cats, and has been a vital resource in reducing the homeless cat population of north Mississippi. Some of our local animal shelters can assist neighborhoods with loaning equipment (traps), safety protocols, questions on how to best help our stray community cats, and additional information on getting homeless cats spayed/neutered and vaccinated to reduce the risk of infectious disease and increase quality of life. Neighborhoods with outdoor community cats that keep producing new litters can be introduced to the best method of achieving a solution (TNR), shown correct procedures to ensure safety requirements are followed, and coordinate neighborhood efforts. ***Desoto County has varying city/county policies regarding trapping, neutering, vaccinating, and returning stray cats due to variations in each code of ordinances. Always call your local shelter to ask their specific TNR policy information first. *Residents whose shelter may not be able to assist with TNR in their service area due to specific animal ordinances* (Olive Branch Animal Shelter- Sec. 10-31 of City Code of Ordinances and Southaven Animal Shelter- Sec 3 of City Code of Ordinances should join TNR Desoto on Next Door for additional information .

Desoto County's first, only, and most vital source of TNR (trap, neuter/spay, vaccinate, return) information and expertise is Pals of Paws Society, who aims to educate residents about the many benefits TNR provides our community, including cost-effectively and humanely reducing the homeless cat population, reducing the spread of infectious disease through vaccinations, saving municipal/county animal shelters billions yearly in taxpayer funds to account for the 80% of total intake attributed to stray kittens draining limited shelter resources each year, reducing our shelters' need to euthanize healthy animals due to overcrowded conditions, and reduces the total amount of general noise/nuisance complaints animal control officers must attend to that divert focus away from animal welfare. *All animals adopted from our local municipal/county shelters (Horn Lake Animal Shelter, Southaven Animal Shelter, Hernando Animal Shelter, Olive Branch Animal Shelter, and Desoto County Animal Shelter) will be spayed/neutered before adoption (All cats will be spayed/neutered prior to adoption; dogs may receive veterinary vouchers) and can receive free vaccination boosters, free full vaccination rounds, and free physical exams at www.thepethospitals.com within 30 days of adoption date.
