



General Information Group Clinic

- A Waiver is required from all class participants. ***Please sign Waiver and return with deposit to the Clinic Sponsor – Make checks payable to Clay Wright.***
- Enrollment is on a first come, first serve basis.
- A **\$100** Non-Refundable deposit is required to hold your space in each class for group clinics.
- A Non-Refundable deposit of **total cost** is required for one-on-one lessons.
- A deposit is considered a commitment to ride. Refunds will only be given for emergencies at the discretion of Clay Wright.
- All students signed up for a class may observe the other classes/lessons at no additional charge - ALL OTHER AUDITORS WILL BE CHARGED A SPECTATOR FEE. **\$30.00** PER DAY.
- We recommend that you bring a Dee Ring Snaffle bit, or a hackamore. (Bosal - not a mechanical hack.) A rope halter is suggested as well.
- Please have horses up to date on all vaccinations. If you are traveling out of state, check with your veterinarian for papers required.
- Please contact sponsor in advance for specifics on boarding, feed, care and stall care, as each location may vary.
- Any participant under 18 years of age, paid enrollment allows you to be accompanied by one parent or guardian at no additional cost - SPECTATOR FEE APPLIES TO ALL OTHERS.
- Arena fees will be divided among all participants and handled by the sponsor.
