Sub:- Instructions on inspections, enquiry report forwarding – reg.

Ref:- 1) Minutes of the Electrical Inspectors' Conference dated 29/8/06.

2) Inspection of District offices by Chief Electrical Inspector.

As per reference (1) it was decided that temporary installations like Punja in Alappuzha, Kottayam, Pathanamthitta districts and temporary installations for Kole fields in Thrissur and Malappuram districts and temporary installations for hoardings, banners, etc along and across roads in the vicinity of Electric lines, etc which do not require statutory inspections should not be inspected and certified from this Department. But contrary to this decision, it is seen that the practice of inspecting and issuing sanction for these type of installations are being continued in some Districts now also. So it is clearly instructed that inspections which do not require statutory inspection should not be inspected and certified in future.

On inspection of various district offices, it is seen that even though enquiry into the electrical accidents are immediately done, the reports are not forwarded to Chief Electrical Inspector's office within a reasonable time. It may be noted that the maximum time allowed to send a report is within one month from the date of accident. This shall be strictly followed. The pending accident reports as on 15/12/06 should be forwarded from District offices within a fortnight positively. If it is not possible to finalize any of the report, this has to be informed within the time limit.

The report of this shall be acknowledged.
