

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CIRCULATING NOMINATION PAPERS (PLEASE FOLLOW EXACTLY)

Thank you for helping our campaign! Here are some items to help ensure all signatures are counted:

- 1) You can begin circulating nomination papers immediately. Anyone in Waukesha County can sign them. For your reference, a list of towns, cities, and villages in Waukesha County is printed on the back of the nomination paper.
- 2) You are the circulator at the bottom of the sheet. Please complete the information but do not date this until **AFTER** all of your contacts have put their signature on. If the circulator date is before any of the signors, all signatures are thrown out by Election Officials. NOTE: Notarization of paper is not required.
- 3) All electors must print and sign their names, and then complete the remaining information. Please ensure the municipality is accurate, as this is often skipped. Note it is permissible for you, the circulator, to add any elector's missing or illegible address or add the date to an individual signature.
- 4) As a circulator, you must present the paper to each elector. For example, you cannot leave the nomination papers unattended on counters or posted on billboards.
- 5) All electors must be 18 years of age or older and reside in Waukesha County, Wisconsin. All circulators (you) must be 18 years of age or older, but do not need to reside in Waukesha County.

Instructions for Returning the Nomination Papers

Please return nomination papers to the Kapenga for Taxpayers campaign no later than 8/30/26. If you cannot return a full sheet, please return a partial sheet as every signature counts!
