ACA 5 Repeal of the ban on Affirmative Action

Assembly Constitutional Amendment 5 passed the California State Senate on June 24. Because it is a proposed constitutional amendment, it must appear as a November 2020 ballot proposition asking voters to repeal Proposition 209's provisions. **This amendment would repeal the ban on Affirmative Action in California. ACA 6 Allowing Parolees the Right to Vote

Assembly Constitutional Amendment 6 passed the California State Senate on June 25. ACA 6 will ask California voters to restore the right to vote to people on parole in the 2020 ballot. ACA 6 is accompanied by AB 646, which enacts corresponding changes to California's Elections Code. The North Carolina NAACP has a strong campaign throughout the state with multiple activities. We currently have 1000 postcards to send to voters in North Carolina.
