Introduction

Welcome to the Cadet Combat Challenge! We are excited to have you join us. To ensure that all participants have a positive experience, please review the following Code of Conduct with your Cadets/Explorers. This form must be signed by an advisor and returned at registration.

1. Respectful Communication

- Treat all participants, staff, and volunteers with respect and courtesy.
- Be mindful of your language, tone, and behavior.
- Disrespect of or arguing with any judges will not be tolerated and may result in your disqualification from the event.

2. Inclusive Environment

- We are committed to creating an inclusive environment free from discrimination, harassment, and intimidation.
- Discrimination, harassment, or abuse based on race, ethnicity, gender identity, sexual orientation, religion, ability, or any other status is strictly prohibited.
- Please be supportive of individuals with different backgrounds, abilities, and experiences.

3. Harassment-Free Zone

- Harassment of any kind, including but not limited to unwanted physical contact, inappropriate comments, stalking, and intimidation, will not be tolerated.
- If you feel uncomfortable or experience harassment, please immediately report it to event staff or organizers.

4. Safety

- In case of any emergency or medical issues, contact event staff or venue security for assistance.
- Follow all health and safety guidelines.

5. Professionalism and Integrity
