THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

We often get asked question around daily operations, expiry dates etc, so here's a quick reference guide to ensure you're up to date.

VACCINATIONS

- We require all dogs to have up to date C5 vaccinations.
- YES, we accept titre testing for C3 component of vaccinations.
- Dogs are to skip a minimum of 3 days of school following booster vaccinations
- We are required to have vaccination details on record for all dogs using our service.
- Please update through the booking portal or email hello@littleurbanwolves.com.au

DAYCARE PACKAGE EXPIRY

All daycare packages have expiry dates.

- 10 Packs = 12 week expiry
- 5 Packs = 6 week expiry

If you are planning time away, please let us know beforehand so we can support you with an extension to your expiry date. We cannot extend a package without prior conversation.

PARKING

Please be mindful of our neighbouring businesses and local when parking your car.

We recommend parking in Park Rd or Hillcrest St. from there it's a short walk around to our shop front on Parramatta Road.

Parking on Parramatta Road and on Wagyu Cart property, is prohibited.

How our clients use our local area reflects directly on our business, so please be thoughtful.

DROP OFF AND PICK UP

Our operating hours are 7am - 6.30pm Monday to Friday.

Drop offs are open from 7am - 10am. We stop drop offs at 10am to support our daily structured program for all dogs in attendance.

Afternoon pick-ups are paused daily from 2 - 3 pm to support rest and recovery time for all dogs in attendance.

DOG POO DISPOSAL

If your dog does a poo on their way to, or from, school, please ensure you pick it up. Let's all play our part in caring for our local area, and minimise the risk of illness to other dogs.

We have dog tidy bags available at reception.

We're always happy for you to hand your poo to us for disposal.

Titre Testing: Fewer Vaccines, Same Protection

Did you know your dog may not need repeat vaccinations every year—or even every three years? At our clinic, we've been offering titre testing for over 20 years to check immunity levels and avoid unnecessary vaccines.

What is Titre Testing?

A titre test measures antibodies in your dog's blood for viral diseases like parvovirus, distemper, and adenovirus. Research shows these vaccines often provide long-lasting or even lifelong immunity once the puppy series and young adult booster are complete.

We usually start titre testing after the puppy vaccines finish or after the first annual booster, and then repeat titres whenever vaccine risk assessments are due according to vaccine manufacturers' schedules—rather than vaccinating automatically.

Are Titre Results Proven Protective?

Yes. Titre testing is widely accepted in veterinary and human medicine:

- Rabies quarantine in Australia: Strict quarantine authorities require rabies titres to confirm protection before pets enter the country—vaccination records alone aren't accepted.
- Hepatitis B in humans: Healthcare workers use titres to confirm immunity and avoid unnecessary boosters, proving this method is reliable and mainstream.
- AAHA Guidelines: The American Animal Hospital Association (AAHA) vaccination guidelines confirm that positive titres for canine distemper virus, parvovirus, and adenovirus correlate strongly with protective immunity. This means a positive titre indicates your dog does not need revaccination for these diseases.

While titre cut-offs can vary between labs, we interpret them carefully and always consider your pet's overall health and lifestyle. Even if they are low, it can still mean protection for some adult dogs.

Why Fewer Vaccines Can Be Safer

- Reduces vaccine-related risks: One rare but serious side effect of unnecessary vaccination is immune-mediated hemolytic anemia (IMHA)—a life-threatening autoimmune condition where the immune system attacks red blood cells (Duval & Giger, JAVMA, 1996). https://onlinelibrary.wiley.com/doi/abs/10.1111/j.1939-1676.1996.tb02064.x
- Tailored to your pet's health: Vaccine manufacturers recommend vaccinating only "healthy pets." If your dog has allergies, autoimmune disease, cancer, or other chronic conditions, we weigh the risks and benefits before revaccinating.
- Bacterial vaccines handled separately: Titre testing applies to viral diseases. Bacterial
 vaccines (like leptospirosis or kennel cough) provide shorter immunity, so we assess
 these separately.

Our Experience

Most dogs who've had their puppy vaccines and a young adult booster remain protected for many years—often for life. By testing rather than guessing, we avoid unnecessary vaccines and reduce risk.

Affordable Peace of Mind

Titre testing can cost over \$400 at some clinics, but we offer it for just \$125. This gives you confidence in your dog's protection—without over-vaccinating.
