Prepare an emergency kit with essentials.

- 3-day supply of non-perishable food that does not require cooking
- 3-day supply of water
- Radio & batteries
- Essential medications
- Essential baby items
- Essential pet items
- Essential toiletry items

- Small tool kit
- · Flashlight
- Gloves
- · Credit card or cash
- Valuable papers and memories
- Insurance policy
- · Birth certificates
- · Immunization records

PREPARE YOUR HOME BEFORE YOU LEAVE

- Shut off propane at the tank or natural gas at the meter.
- · Turn off all pilot lights.
- · Close all exterior vents.
- · Close all exterior doors and windows.
- · Close all interior doors.
- Prop a ladder against the house to provide firefighters with easy roof access.
- Connect garden hoses to faucets with spray nozzles attached.
- · Move exterior furniture away from your home.
- Screen your chimney to prevent embers from entering your home.
- If you have combustible roofing (shakes) place a sprinkler on the roof so fire fighters can turn on if needed.
- · Place a ladder on the ground visible to firefighters

EVACUATION LEVELS

Be familiar with these levels. Because we live in the Wildland Urban Interface upper county residents should always be at Level 1.



LEVEL 1 - READYBe fire-adapted and ready

Take personal responsibility and prepare long before the threat of a wildland fire. Create defensible space by clearing brush away from your home. Use fire-resistant landscaping. Assemble emergency supplies and belongings in a safe place. Plan escape routes and make sure all those residing in the home know the plan of action.



LEVEL 2 - SETSituational awareness

Pack your emergency items. Know how to receive and stay aware of the latest news and information on the fire from local media, your local fire department and public safety. To stay informed, follow the Roslyn Fire Department on social media and tune into local radio stations and news outlets.



LEVEL 3 - GO! Act early

Follow your personal wildland fire action plan as early as possible. Also, be sure to adhere to evacuation instructions as soon as you receive them. Drive slowly and carefully out evacuation routes. Firefighting resources will likely be headed in and/or working along the roadway.
