

Kindness Appreciated

Luke 6:31-35; Ephesians 4:32

Everyone appreciates it when they are treated kindly by another. There are people we expect it from (friends) and those from whom it comes as a pleasant surprise (complete strangers). Nevertheless, everyone likes it. A good question to ask yourself is whether you're as good at giving kindness as you are receiving it.

A great example of kindness is the way our Heavenly Father treats us. During a series of teachings on the way we should behave toward others, Jesus noted that God treats with kindness even those who are ungrateful and evil. Which occasionally includes...well...all of us!

Kindness should be an identifying mark of every Christian in conduct toward their brothers and sisters. Note Ephesians 4:32 enfolds tenderheartedness and forgiveness for each other along with being kind, or perhaps as identifying attributes of a truly kind person. The standard of forgiveness in this verse is no less than the very forgiveness God blesses us with through Jesus Christ.

What does the Greek term translated "kind" in the New Testament really mean? W.E. Vine comments that the word "primarily signifies "fit for use, able to be used," hence, "good, virtuous, mild, pleasant" (in contrast to what is hard, harsh, sharp, bitter)." One gets the idea that a truly kind person is one whose demeanor offers a comforting, relaxing aspect; a welcoming that extends to everyone they meet, fellow believer or not. After all, God shows kindness to all (Luke 6:35) and God's kindness has the purpose of leading all toward repentance (Romans 2:4).

So, kindness is a gift we can offer that we might grow in good relationship with one another, and to show the world the true nature of God. Make it your goal to praise the Father for His kindness, and let it be expressed in your words and actions each day.
