How the FLU spreads

Most experts believe that flu viruses spread mainly by tiny droplets made when people with flu cough, sneeze, or talk. These droplets can land in the mouths or noses of people who are nearby. Less often, a person might get flu by touching a surface or object that has flu virus on it and then touching their own mouth, nose or eyes.

Prevention

The first and most important step in preventing flu is to get a flu vaccine each year. Flu vaccine has been shown to reduce flu-related illnesses and the risk of serious flu complications that can result in hospitalization or even death. CDC also recommends everyday preventive actions (like staying away from people who are sick [\(distancing\)](#), [covering coughs and sneezes](#), [frequent handwashing](#), and [taking steps for cleaner air](#)) to help slow the spread of germs that cause respiratory (nose, throat, and lungs) illnesses like flu.

Contact your healthcare provider or local health department to get your flu vaccine today! **Don't delay because it takes 2 WEEKS after the flu vaccine is given for you to receive protection from the flu.**
