2 Peter 1:5-8

THE FLU VACCINES ARE AVAILABLE NOW!

People often ask me, “Can you get the flu from the flu shot?” No, you cannot. The shot is made from the dead flu virus that can't cause influenza infection. You can however get brief flu-like symptoms which may feel like you have the flu.

I have had asthma all my life, was born with it and never outgrew it. Because of my asthma it puts me at a higher risk of catching the flu and then it is leading into pneumonia. Now that I am 63 years old, I have a naturally declining immune response that just comes with aging. That's why it's especially important that I get a yearly flu vaccine.

I found this statistic frightening this year. . . The flu and pneumonia were the 8th leading cause of death in the U.S. in 2025, up from 11th only a year ago. While each flu season differs in severity, during most seasons, people 65 and older bear the greatest burden of disease. CDC estimates that between 70-85% of seasonal flu-related deaths and between 50-70% of seasonal flu-related hospitalizations occur in older adults.

By the way, Publix is providing free flu vaccines and if you get one from them, they will hand you an electronic gift certificate for \$5.00. I usually wait until October to get my vaccine, but I am going ahead and getting it now. Another reason to get your vaccine asap is because it will take up to two weeks in your system before it begins to help provide immunity.
