Dear **Representative [NAME]**,

As a resident of Michigan, I'm extremely concerned about the rapid, under-regulated expansion of AI data centers across the state. As a member of the House Committee on Government Operations, I'm asking you to bring HB 5594-5596 (the Data Center Regulation Act) to a vote in committee, and to approve it.

Michigan's local zoning, state regulations, and utilities are not ready for the volume and pace of hyperscale data center buildout that's currently proposed. This kind of buildout and resource consumption demands thoughtful strategy. We're dealing with Michigan residents' ability to heat their homes during the winter and access clean water. This is no time for Silicon Valley's "move fast and break things" approach. As a Michigan taxpayer, I am not willing to gamble the future of my community and the health of the Great Lakes.

A statewide moratorium would give townships and counties time to develop zoning ordinances to properly address hyperscale data centers; it would give regulators and communities time to research impacts on Michigan's water, energy, and environment; and it would provide legislators time to develop a consistent energy and climate strategy.

Please approve the Data Center Regulation Act, so that the House can approve it.
