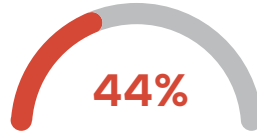
WHAT WE'VE LEARNED THE STATS

Definition of Food Insecurity: Families can pay all the bills, but do not have the finances to put food on the table.





WHEN HELPING HURTS:

In 2023, the Love Lubbock Leadership team was trained in the methodologies and practices of "When Helping Hurts," provided by The Chalmers Center.

"Poor people typically talk in terms of shame, inferiority, powerlessness, humiliation, fear, hopelessness, depression, social isolation, and voicelessness. North American audiences tend to emphasize a lack of material things such as food, money, clean water, medicine, housing, etc." (When Helping Hurts, Corbett & Fikkert)

"Poverty alleviation is the ministry of reconciliation: moving people closer to glorifying God by living in right relationship with God, self, others, and the rest of creation..." (Corbett & Fikkert)
