### Certification Qualifications

Must be a member in good standing of the NCTA and meet one of the three following qualifications in Professional Competition.

One 1<sup>st</sup> Place blue ribbon and Best of Category  
One 1<sup>st</sup> Place blue ribbon plus 5 other Points  
Two 2<sup>nd</sup> Place red ribbons plus 5 other points

### Points System

1st place = 4 Points  
2nd place = 3 Points  
3rd place = 2 Points
