Jessie Harris currently serves as a Transportation Specialist for the Administration for Strategic Preparedness and Response (ASPR) within the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. In this role, he schedules and monitors the movement and delivery of Strategic National Stockpile (SNS) resources, participates in the development of short- and long-range strategic plans and policies, recommends implementation of initiatives to aid in the movement of critical SNS resources to the American public, and participates in training exercises with the Department of Defense, Department of Transportation, other Federal Agencies, and private industry partners to test and improve transportation and logistics capabilities.

Prior to his current role, Jessie worked for the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) as a Transportation Management Specialist, where he evaluated plans for logistical feasibility, coordinated with federal, state, local, tribal and nongovernment agencies, and commercial contractors in support of FEMA's Incident Management mission. Jessie ensured the timely and accurate movement and delivery of critical lifesaving commodities and equipment to hurricane and flood survivors during natural and man-made disasters throughout the United States and it territories. In addition, he performed Contracting Officer Representative duties ensuring the agency received agreed upon services and products in accordance with contractual agreements. As the General Manager for Million Air Victorville, a Fixed Base Operations at the Southern California Logistics Airport, Jessie oversaw day-to-day operations, synchronized and integrated all logistics functions (maintenance, facilities, finance, procurement, transportation, inventory management, property, and safety) for aircraft fueling, services, and cargo operations.

Jessie is a 30-year Army Veteran. He served in the United States Army Transportation Corps in a variety of transportation, logistics, and leadership roles supporting the distribution, transportation, movement control, and procurement of military equipment, supplies, and personnel. Some of his accomplishments include recognition by the United States Army Europe's, Commanding General for his partnership and training development with the Polish National Army, overseeing the logistics, distribution, and movement of 3M gallons of fuel, 10K tons of cargo, 3K tons of ammunition, and 10K personnel during a multinational training event, and authoring an article that was published in the "Army Magazine".

He holds a MS in Management from Excelsior College and has received training in Logistics Operations, Workforce and Personnel Management, Mobilization/Distribution Planning, Strategic Distribution Planning, and Training Management. Jessie recently achieved certification as a Certified Master Logistician (CML) through SOLE-The International Society of Logistics and is a certified Project Management Professional (PMP) through the Project Management Institute.
