Dear Valued Vendor:

On behalf of the Queen Creek Juneteenth Planning Committee, I would like to extend an invitation to you for our upcoming Queen Creek Juneteenth Jubilee in Queen Creek, Arizona.

The purpose of this event is to commemorate the emancipation of enslaved people in the United States.

Juneteenth (June 19th) marks the day when federal troops arrived in Galveston, Texas in 1865 to declare that slavery had been abolished and to ensure that all enslaved people be freed. The troops' arrival came a full two and a half years after the signing of the Emancipation Proclamation of 1863. Juneteenth honors the end of slavery in the United States.

We believe it is extremely important to recognize the significance of Juneteenth, as it is an official US Federal Holiday.

The event will begin with a prayer and the singing of the Black National Anthem, Lift Every Voice and Sing. We endeavor to have cultural orators, live performance, music, food, vendors, and Queen Creek Juneteenth T-shirts for sale - for all attendees to enjoy. The American Red Cross will also be onsite for blood donations and sickle cell identification.

This will be a FREE event and open to the entire public community at the Desert Mountain Park in Queen Creek, Arizona (Saturday, June 20, 2026 10am – 2pm). Set up will be 8am - 10am and clean up will be 2pm – 4pm. All vendors must be off the park property by 4pm.

As this is an OUTDOOR event – please be prepared for the weather. The event will be held rain or shine. Tents will be provided.

Participation on the part of your organization is paramount to our achieving the desired successful outcome in acknowledging and celebrating the diversity of our great Town. Your value of customers in the African American community and beyond will be showcased, but most of all appreciated. Recognition of diversity in our community is at an all-time high and you want to be a part of this growing positive effort.

All payments for vendor participation/registration (\$100.00) will be done through our GOFUNDME account and will be used for production of this event and future Queen Creek Juneteenth events.
