On behalf of the Queen Creek Juneteenth Planning Committee, I would like to extend an invitation to you for our upcoming Queen Creek Juneteenth Jubilee in Queen Creek, Arizona.

The purpose of this event is to commemorate the emancipation of enslaved people in the United States.

Juneteenth (June 19th) marks the day when federal troops arrived in Galveston, Texas in 1865 to declare that slavery had been abolished and to ensure that all enslaved people be freed. The troops' arrival came a full two and a half years after the signing of the Emancipation Proclamation of 1863. Juneteenth honors the end of slavery in the United States.

We believe it is extremely important to recognize the significance of Juneteenth, as it is an official US Federal Holiday.

The event will begin with a prayer and the singing of the Black National Anthem, Lift Every Voice and Sing. We endeavor to have cultural orators, live performance, music, food, vendors, and Queen Creek Juneteenth T-shirts for sale - for all attendees to enjoy. The American Red Cross will also be onsite for blood donations and sickle cell identification. The registration QR code is listed below.

This will be a FREE event and open to the entire public community at the Desert

Vendor Categories: Food sales are strictly limited to those who have registered as official food vendors. If you are registered as a general vendor, you are not permitted to sell any food items at your booth.
