CIGNA SUNDAY STREETS

The City of Houston, with sponsor Cigna Insurance, has hosted multiple neighborhood events over the last five years all over town. The City closes down streets to vehicular traffic to permit the community to walk, cycle, roller blade around their community. The goal is for residents to experience community, food, healthy living & entertainment. On October 20th, Noon to 4:00 PM, Sunday Streets will come to Spring Branch again and will be set up along the following streets: Gessner south from Westview to Mathewson Lane then west to Conrad Sauer then north to Westview. Mathewson Lane is the new east-west street just north of I-10 that runs behind the new Cemex Building at Gessner & I-10. The Conrad Sauer detention basin has been landscaped and trails have been added that can be used by the public. The Sunday Streets route was chosen partly to introduce the neighborhood to this new amenity. Businesses & organizations are encouraged to participate by setting up a booth along the route. MID-TERM ELECTIONS

Election day is November 5th and early voting commences October 21st. This year there are numerous races on the ballot that are important to our community, such as Mayor, Controller, District A City Council and At-Large City Council. <u>ALL</u> 16 City Council positions will be on the ballot.

Some City Council races will include an incumbent; however, our current City Council representative, Brenda Stardig, is term limited and cannot run for re-election. As of this writing, we are aware of the following candidates for District A: lesheia Ayers-Wilson, Mehdi Cherkaoui, Marina Coryat, Lois Myers (an SBCA resident), Amy Peck (Brenda Stardig's Chief of Staff) & George

Zoes. Spring Branch West Super Neighborhood will host a District A Candidate Forum on Thursday, October 10th, 7:30 PM, St. Christopher's Episcopal Church, 1656 Blalock, Latham Parish Hall. All candidates are confirmed to attend.

The Mayoral race is very crowded with at least twelve candidates including incumbent Sylvester Turner. For a current list of candidates for each race, go to https://www.houstontx.gov/2019-general-election.html.

BRIAR BRANCH CREEK PROJECT

Construction continues on this drainage project which includes drainage "straws" in Springrock Ln, Windhover, Demaret, and Larston. The straws are intended to drain stormwater off the low points on some streets in our neighborhood. Three side-by-side box culverts ranging in size from 7'x7' to 10'x8' are being installed in Briar Branch Creek from Gessner east to the Briar Branch Detention Basin which is east of the Costco detention pond. This will enclose the creek and TIRZ 17 will pave the ROW for access by maintenance vehicles only. No public vehicular traffic will be allowed. landscaping & benches will be installed and the roadway will be open as a hike & bike trail. This will be a very nice amenity for us, if safe pedestrian crossings are also installed, with access to businesses, including the new eateries planned on Gessner - Torchy's Tacos, Kirby Ice House & Mia's which will include a large outdoor patio.
