HEAVY TRASH: Our regular heavy trash pickup days are the 4th Wednesday of the month which this month will be Wednesday, November 23rd. November is a TREE WASTE ONLY month which means the City will pick up only TREE WASTE. If you have anything else in your pile, the City won't pick up any of it!! Please be aware of City ordinances concerning when to put your heavy trash out for pick up as well as when and where to put your bins out for regular trash and recycle.
