While our name has changed, our dedication to assisting volunteer firefighters and ambulance crew members in achieving their dreams of homeownership remains as strong as ever.”

The organization, in partnership with the Long Island Housing Partnership (LIHP), facilitates the Employer Assisted Housing Program, which offers up to \$26,000 in down payment assistance and \$24,000 for property improvements to eligible volunteer first responders.
