

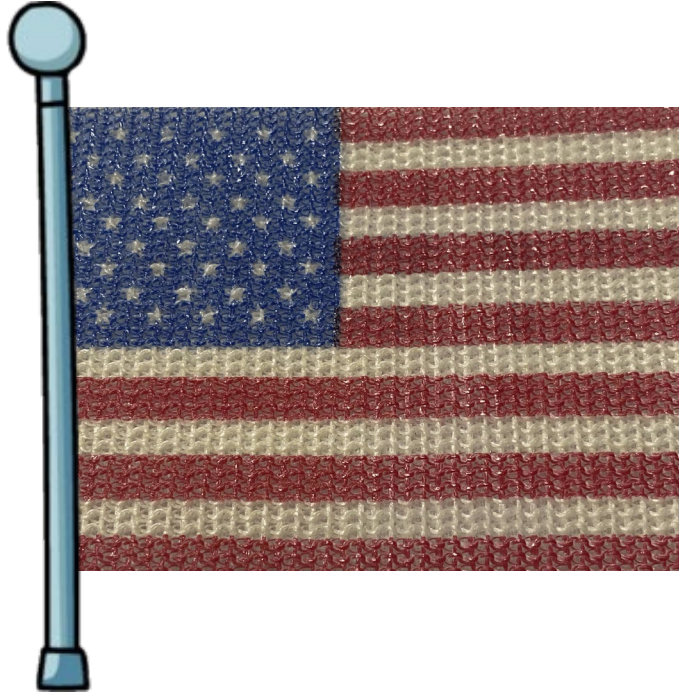

COVID-19 SAFETY INFORMATION:
