## American Legion Bunt Brewer Post 165

### The Town of Hunter, Town Historian, Villages of Hunter, Tannersville

- This program is a living tribute to the service members (alive or passed) from The Town of Hunter who served our Country. It also includes members of the Armed Forces who have Full Time relatives living in the Town, or POST 165 members regardless of past or present residence.
- Each individual banner will be unique and honor a specific former or present resident who served in the Armed Forces. It will include their photo with name, branch of service, and if applicable, non-combat or military conflict in which they served.
- The banners will be 24 x 48 inches and be in full color displayed in the Town of Hunter along the main roads.
- The deadline to mail in the application, payment, and picture is March 1<sup>st</sup>. Please write your name, address, and phone number on the back of your picture, if wish to have it returned after the order is filled and banner is up (Please include a \$5.00 postage charge for returning any photo, or send photo as digital copy for free)

The banner will be on display prior to Memorial Day through Veterans Day (November 11).

The price of the banner is \$135. A visual inspection will be performed yearly to determine if replacement is necessary. **The sponsor is responsible for replacement.**

\*Qualifications needed with the application of the banner:

- Proof of service in the United States Armed Forces (military photo, copy DD-214 etc)
- > The honoree should be a current member of the community, (or have resided here prior to their passing) or sponsoring family living in the community full time.
- The picture should be at least 3 x 5 and no larger than 8 x 10.

The application must be approved by the Hometown Heroes Veterans Banner Committee of American Legion Post 165.
