The 55th Annual Delray Beach St. Patrick's Day Parade Rules

Application Deadline: Monday, March 3, 2025

Parade Participants, please remember that this is a community event and is intended for viewing by families of all ages. Dress and behavior should reflect a "G" rating.

- All must attend the <u>MANDATORY</u> Captain's Meeting on Wednesday, March 12, 2025, 7:00 pm, at the Delray Beach Community Center, 50 NW 1st Ave., Delray Beach, Fl. 33444.
- Non-profits: Must provide proof of 501C3 status. No other entity, including for-profit businesses, can apply under a non-profit's name.
- All applicants must accurately represent their status as marked on the application. The named organization must be the sole participant in the parade.
- Participants must respect and obey the requests and instructions of parade staff at all times. Verbal abuse, disrespect, or disruptive behavior towards staff members will not be tolerated and may result in immediate removal from the parade.
- Drivers: Copies of your driver's license and vehicle insurance are required and must be submitted with the application. Your application will not be accepted without it.
- For safety reasons, children under the age of 6 must ride on a float/vehicle, or be secured in a stroller.
- No alcoholic beverages will be allowed on floats, in the line-up area or during the length of the parade.
 Consumption of such beverages will not be tolerated and will result in immediate removal from the parade and future events thereafter.
- The parade will begin at the Intracoastal, proceed west on Atlantic Avenue to NW 5th Ave . A map showing starting positions and parade route is enclosed.
- Parade Staging area location and staging time to be provided once approved for entrance into the parade.
- Judging for all entries will take place at the Judging Area/MC located towards the west end of the parade route. Dance/Cheer Groups will have the opportunity to a 20-second stationary performance. Stopping will not be permitted anywhere else along the parade route. If you create a gap between entries, you will not be judged.
- Police safety rules prohibit throwing candy or other items from cars, floats, etc. and city ordinance prohibit consumption of alcoholic beverages.
- "Silly String" and "snap 'n pops" are prohibited.
- MYLAR CONFETTI IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in denial of participation in future parades.







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- All entries using sound amplifying devices shall maintain a volume that will not interfere with other entries.
- Maximum Float Height Restriction: 15 feet from the ground.
- No Monster Trucks
- The Parade Producer and Delray Beach Police/Fire Department retain the right to prohibit any unsafe vehicle or trailer from participating in the parade.
- All vehicles must have a valid license plate as required by law and functioning horn, headlights, brake lights and parking lights.
- All flatbed trucks or trailers with riders must have a railing at least 12" above the float platform using wood, metal or a substantial substitute. Consultation with professionals experienced in construction techniques shall be done to ensure the railing will withstand the force imposed upon it by the persons on board.
- No sharp or unfinished edges should be exposed.
- Floats being towed with people on board should have at least one accessible 2A-10BC extinguisher on the float. Each standing float rider must have an approved body support. All seating on towed vehicles or floats must be properly secured.
- All floats must have a minimum of four wheel walkers (adults) stationed on the four "corners" of the float, including tow vehicle. Entries must provide their own walkers.
- No person shall be allowed to get on and off a float after the parade begins, except for emergency reasons. In the case of an emergency, the float should pull to the curb and stop. The person involved in the emergency will be removed and the float may re-enter the parade.
- All groups must march to the end of the parade route, which is NW 5th Ave.
 Note: immediately upon making the turn onto NW 5th Ave., your performance has ended.
 Music and performances must stop.
- All floats must be fireproofed. See parade float safety guidelines.
- Solicitation of funds or selling of merchandise during the parade is not permitted unless approved by the Parade Committee.

DELRAY BEACH PARADE FLOAT SAFETY GUIDELINES

- Decorative material used on parade floats shall be flame resistant.
- A minimum of one (1) ten-pound multipurpose (ABC) fire extinguisher is required for each float. The fire extinguisher must be in an accessible location, be currently certified and maintained in operable condition and present at the time of float inspections.
- A generator or battery must power all electrical appliances.
- All wiring and wiring connections must be located where they are not exposed to physical damage, secured to float, and maintained in a safe condition.
- All generators must be uncovered, and exhaust discharge not located within 3 feet of combustible materials.
- Generators shall not be in enclosed spaces or the passenger compartment of vehicles. (Ex. Hatchback vehicles with the hatch open in not an approved location for a gas-powered (generator).
- All heat sources (lights etc.) must be located away from all combustible materials.
- Safety chains must be affixed to the float and towing vehicle. Chains must be present and affixed at the time of float inspection.
- No open flames are permitted on floats or vehicles.
- Individuals riding on the float must be situated in a secure location, (Seated or provided with a secure handhold e.g. railing, pole, handle).
- Normal unobstructed vision to the front, sides and rear of the towing vehicle must be provided to the vehicle operator.
- All safety devices must be in place and operational at check-in time.

10.17 Parade Floats.

10.17.1 Permits:

Permits, where required, shall comply with Section 1.12.

10.17.2 Fire Protection:

Motorized parade floats and towing apparatus shall be provided with a minimum 2-A:10-B:C-rated portable fire extinguisher readily accessible to the operator.
