FORMAT

CHAMPIONSHIP FLIGHT

- Blue Tees
- 54 holes of medal play
- Low 50% of players in field after 36 holes qualify for Champ on Sunday
- Non-qualifiers play in the President's Flight on Sunday.
- President's Flight will be Sunday score only (**NEW in 2026**)
- All ties will be split, except 1st place (sudden death)
- Player Discussion (Sat/Sun total)
- Skins Game: Each day \$10.00 (cash payout)

SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIP FLIGHT

- White Tees
- 54 Holes of Medal Play
- President's Flight determined after Saturday
- President's Flight will be Sunday score only (**NEW in 2026**)

FLIGHT PLAY

- White & Gold Tees depending on flight
- Friday: Match play 18 holes
- Saturday: Match play 18 holes
- Sunday: Match play 18 holes (4 or 12 man flights would end up playing medal on Sunday)
- All ties will be split

All participants will play all 3 days, 18 holes

Entry Fee: \$225/member, \$300/non member

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RULES OF PLAY

- USGA rules govern & where applicable the following local rules
- You will be notified on the 1st tee what ground condition rules we will be playing > **WINTER RULES IN YOUR OWN FAIRYWAY** (*scorecard length*)
- Ground under repair defined by white lines. Free drop at nearest point of relief, no closer to the hole.
- Roads & Paths: White lines areas tying into roads or paths have the same status as the road or path (obstructions, not ground under repair) Cart path includes extended worn areas and newly seeded cart path edges.
- Out of bounds: Defined by white stakes or lines. Any ball on the line touching the golf course is in play. Any ball on the line not touching a portion of the golf course is out of bounds.
- Players may take relief from decorative rocks if they are in play
- Penalty Areas: Defined by red lines and/or stakes & follow the contour of the penalty area. The stakes/lines are considered in the penalty area.
- Drop Areas for #7 & #13 will be marked. Drop areas are for penalty areas marked red only & are an additional option.
- Suspension of play will be indicated by one blast of the horn.
- Doubt as to procedure
 - Match play: Players must determine at time of question.
 - Medal play: Play a 2nd ball, record both scores & report to scoring
 - Report facts to Rules Official at first chance.
- Scorecards: Please sign and attest all scorecards after the round.
 - Championship Flight will be using iWanamaker app as well
- GPS devices & range finders are permitted.
