Committee News

Lawn and Landscape

The Lawn and Landscaping Committee is responsible for the maintenance, repair, improvement, and beautification of the common grounds. The group obtains bids for repairs or services needed and follows-up on homeowner concerns.

Some of the projects that the committee is focusing on currently include the following.

- It has been brought to the attention of the group that there are overhanging branches next to the tennis court that are dropping debris onto the surface of the court. Solutions are being considered.
- Regarding some of the trees outside the fence and along the Creekside Dr. border of the pool. The pool committee has informed us that pine needles and tree waste are getting into the skimmer and could make its way into the pump. Costly damage could result. Further discussions are being had between the committees on a resolution.
- The committee is gathering ideas for further beautification inside and outside the pool and the village center area.
- The buffer has sustained some damage due to wind, insects, and wildlife. As a result, some trees may need to be replaced. Penn State may again be partnering with Creekside on a solution.
- There are a few trees in the islands along Creekside Dr. that require attention. They will be inspected, and a determination made on a course of action.
- The netting that was used in the basins when planting occurred has become a hindrance when mowing is being done. The committee is currently working on removing netting.
