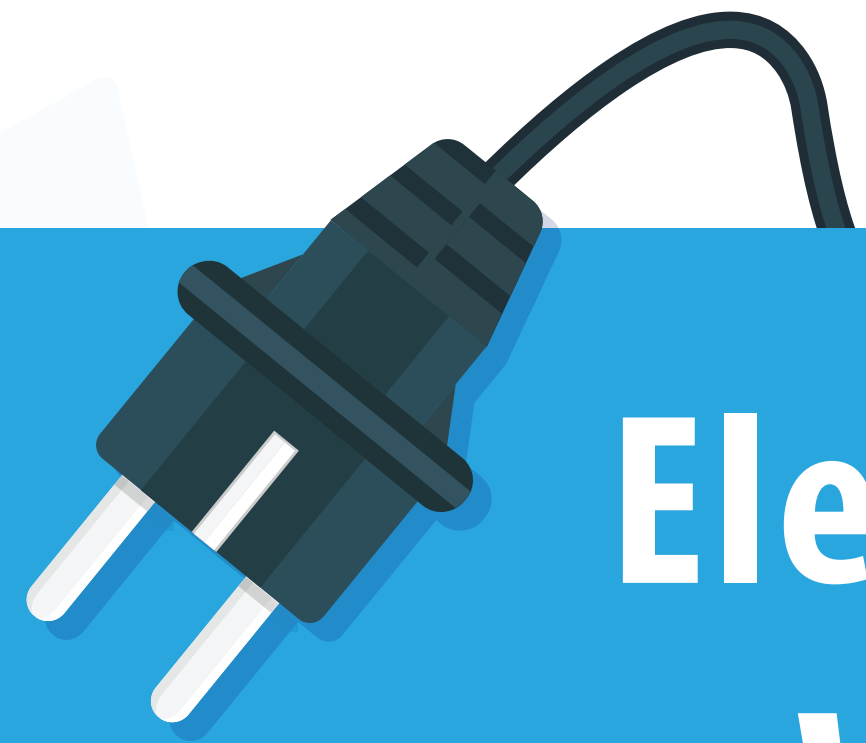


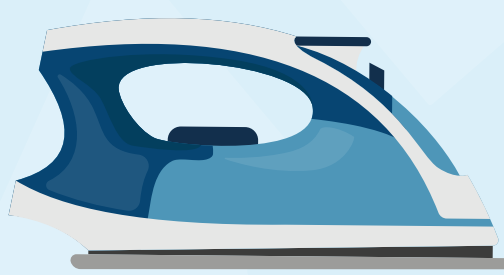
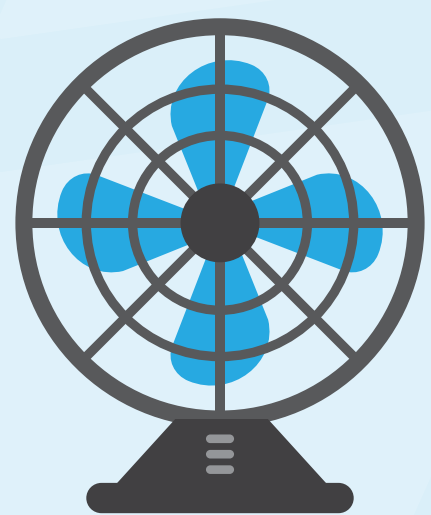
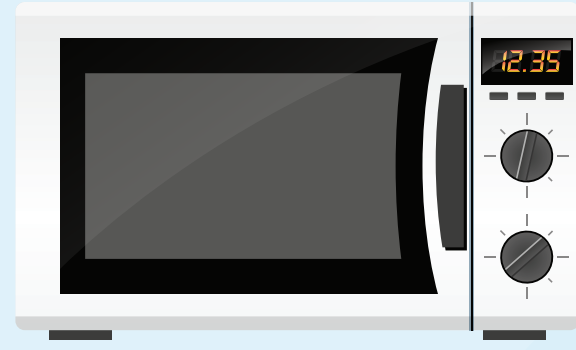
# What is E-Waste?
