"AeroSouth Parts Too Radical"

Following the 2021 Sunfish National Championships on Lake Norman, North Carolina, the Sunfish Class Board announced an exception to its normal rules concerning class legal parts. Made necessary by a shortage of these components, the association's leadership explained the temporary allowance of non-Class Legal parts in sanctioned events. As Sunfish expert Lee Montes **explains in this video** (around 6:50), the AeroSouth rudder blades and daggerboards are deemed **"too radical"** for these events and would not be allowed.

All we can say is: "Thanks for the Compliment!"

AeroSouth does not aim to comply to Class rules, as these would stifle completely our efforts to provide sailors with greater speed, safety and fun on the water. We certainly have no objection to the Class adopting our products, but will leave that discussion up to Class leaders to initiate.

FS Rudder for the Fulcrum Rocket

Thanks to the interest of Vermont sailor Derek Snare the **AeroSouth FS rudder blade** is now available for the **Rocket**, a significant refinement on the Sunfish from **Fulcrum Speedworks** of Bristol, RI. Its overall dimensions and weight are similar to the Sunfish however its rudder attachment is slightly different.

In a fast-tracked collaboration with Derek,

AeroSouth developed a simple but effective pop-up feature similar to the Sunfish. As seen in the image here, this required only the change of position for a spring pin in the rudder's head, and some additional hardware for the attachment to the standard Rocket cheek flange. AeroSouth now offers this simple retrofit kit at a nominal add-on to the price of our FS rudder blade.

Dinghy Bob Refined, Used on More Boats

Dinghy Bob, Aerosouth's unique combination rig-flotation device and wind direction indicator, continues to gain acceptance among sailors. As a result of a customer request, AeroSouth has recently confirmed its suitability for the **Vanguard**

Zuma sailboat, and made the first shipment to an owner of this popular Catrigged dinghy, **Jim DeYoung of the Bass Lake Sailing Club** in Knox, IN. Thanks for being a pioneer, Jim DeYoung!

We also believe that Dinghy Bob would install without modification on the popular **Optimist**, one of the best-known school sailboats in the world.

Based on a good suggestion from competitive Sunfish sailor **Emily Wagner of Tampa, Florida**, AeroSouth now ships special **reusable zip ties** with each Dinghy Bob, an alternative to the quick-release stainless steel hose clamps initially supplied. FS Rudder & Wishbone Tillers

The original AeroSouth FS rudder blades were developed using standard blade and tiller attachment from ca. 2020. This included a pair of small, metal "straps" that connect the tiller to the head (top) of the rudder blade. Many sailors however use a "wishbone" style of tiller, which some state as being stiffer and more responsive than those attached with straps.

Recently **Rick Schlosser of Sharon, Massachusetts** attached a wishbone tiller from **Nautos** (part HT7042) to his FS. This required the drilling of an additional 1/4" diameter hole as seen in the image here. AeroSouth has updated its User Guide for the blade, **found here on our web site**, with drawings to show the purpose and location of all the various holes in the head of the FS rudder blades, including this one for a wishbone tiller.


See AeroSouth at Regattas
