UTILITY LINE PROGRAM

Water and Sewer line repair coverage for Superior homeowners through *Service Line Warranties of America (SLWA)* Water and Sewer Line Warranty Program

~no pre-existing conditions/no wait from enrollment date before filing a claim

Covers repairs or replacement of a leaking or broken single underground water supply line serving the home. The warranty covers the consumer owned portion of the water supply line. Covers the repair or replacement of a broken underground sewer line from the utility's main sewer line to the internal point of entry to the home.

CodeRED is a notification system and service that enable Sweetwater Combined Communications Center to quickly, accurately, and automatically send emergency and informational messages to thousands of contacts, via phone, text messages, and e-mail. If an individual would like to have their cell phone included

ICE (In Case of Emergency)

In case of emergency (ICE) is a program that enables first responders, such as paramedics, firefighters, and police officers, as well as hospital personnel, to contact the next of kin of the owner of a cell phone to obtain important medical or support information (the phone must be unlocked and working). A person can list multiple emergency contacts as "ICE", "ICE1", "ICE2", etc.
