**If you are joining or renewing your membership at the show, please use separate check for annual dues**

**\*\*Each horse/rider combination will be given **one set** (2) of numbers for the entire show season. If the number is lost or misplaced, it is the riders responsibility to replace it with the same number. Numbers are not to be shared or changed during the show season and must be displayed prominently during competition\*\***

**Show Day:** Check-in begins at approximately 8:30am. Classes will begin promptly at 9:30am. Show grounds are located 1 mile south of Veterans Highway (Rt 454), and 3 miles North of Sunrise Highway (Rt 27). Adjacent to Connetquot Park

### END OF YEAR (EOY) QUALIFICATIONS

#### OVERALL HIGH POINT AWARDS (HPAs)

We are bringing back overall End of Day and End of Year Grand and Reserve High Point Awards. For EOY awards, you must declare your division when you submit your first entries to the first show. No changes will be accepted (Open to all except Walk-Jog entrants). In-Hand classes, Reining, and Ranch classes will not count towards HPAs.

#### End of Year Awards (EOY)

1. You must be in good standing with Islip Horsemen's Association, and have current membership status for your points to be counted towards End of Year awards and placings
2. To qualify for EOY awards, you must have shown 2 out of 3 shows. Reiners **must score** in 2 out of 3 shows to qualify. For Division EOY, you must show 2 of 3 shows, with a minimum of 3 division classes per show
3. In the event of an injury to your horse mid-season, a veterinary note will be required if there is a substituted horse; back number will remain the same.

**EOY DIVISION AWARDS** will be based on the highest cumulative point standings at the end of the season division class (Showmanship, Trail, Horsemanship, and Pleasure for each division). **You must show in a minimum of 3 division classes, at 2/3 of the shows**

**EOY CLASS AWARDS** will be presented to the overall Grand and Reserve Champions in Halter, Colorbreed Halter, In-Hand Trail, and Reining, with ribbons to 6<sup>th</sup> place

## WESTERN DIVISION DESCRIPTIONS

### **Leadline**

Open to riders eight (8) years old and under. Leadline riders may show in this division only

### **Buckaroo**

Open to those who have phased out of leadline, and are under the age of 12. Classes are walk-jog only

### **Walk /Jog (Youth & Adult combined)**

Open to riders who have never ridden in any discipline which requires riders to lope in a group. In Walk/Jog, riders must ride one-handed with an approved AQHA shank bit. Riders may ride in the Walk/Jog division for a maximum of three years. Riders who have earned a Champion or Reserve Champion EOY award twice, will advance after two years. Walk/Jog riders may also enter in-hand classes

### **Beginner/Green (Youth & Adult combined)**

Walk/Jog/Lope division that is open to riders who have advanced out of the Walk/Jog Division, or who are cross-entering from any other discipline with no restrictions on previous wins. Also open to a horse in its 1st or 2nd year of showing Western Pleasure. Horses in this division may be ridden in an AQHA approved snaffle or bosal regardless of age, and may be ridden two-handed. Horses in any kind of shank bit must be ridden one-handed. Riders may ride in this division for a maximum of three (3) years. Riders who have earned a Champion or Reserve EOY award for two consecutive years will advance to the Amateur division

### **Amateur**

Open to riders who have advanced out of the Beginner Division with no restrictions on previous wins. Riders may ride in the Amateur division for a maximum of three (3) years. Riders who have earned a Champion or Reserve Champion end-of-year award for two consecutive years will advance after two years

### **Open**

Open to any rider (including trainers) who do not meet the qualifications for any other divisions. Riders in this division may not revert to a lower division

### **Ranch**

Split into 2 subdivisions, **Intro** (Walk/Jog only) and **Open** (Walk/Jog/Lope). Riders must show in **both** Ranch Rail Pleasure and Ranch Riding to qualify for EOY division awards, **and** 2 out of 3 shows. \*\*If the rider cross-enters, and shows in a W/J/L Western Pleasure class, they cannot show in Intro (W/J) Ranch classes\*\*

## WESTERN CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

### Halter/Colorbreed Halter

Horses to be shown in hand are judged on overall confirmation, balance and soundness. Exhibitors will be asked to walk & jog their horses at the direction of the judge and to line up head to tail and stand for inspection. Colorbreed halter is restricted to horses of color organizations (Paint, Pinto, Palomino, Appaloosa, Roan, Buckskin, etc.)

### Showmanship at Halter

Horses to be shown in hand with emphasis on exhibitor's ability to groom a horse to show at halter and follow a pattern. Exhibitors will be judged on their ability to execute maneuvers described in a pattern.

### In-Hand Trail

Horses to be judged over a series of obstacles at the walk and jog. Not limited to: Ground tying, side-passing, backing, bridges, walking/jogging over ground poles or obstacles you would see in an under saddle trail class. A horse can be shown in a leather, nylon, or rope halter with a standard length lead. No training aids such as crops or carrot sticks may be used. Proper western attire will be required.

### Leadline

To be judged at the walk and jog on horsemanship and suitability. Trail class will be judged at the walk and jog over three or more obstacles.

### Western Pleasure

Judged on performance, manners, condition, and conformation as a pleasure mount. Horses will be judged at the walk, jog and lope on a reasonably loose rein. Horses will be asked to back up either on the rail or in the lineup. **Exception:** Walk/jog exhibitors shall show on the rail at the walk and jog only; Walk/Jog/Individual Lope exhibitors will show on the rail, and lope individually at the discretion of the judge or the steward. **\*\*EXTENSION of Gaits may be asked for at the discretion of the judge\*\***

### Horsemanship/Equitation

Exhibitors are judged on their ability to execute a prescribed pattern, performing each maneuver as smoothly as possible, while keeping a balanced body position. Exhibitors will be asked to walk/jog/lope as a group at least one direction of the arena.

### Trail

Exhibitors will be asked to maneuver their horses over a series of natural obstacles at the walk, jog and lope. Obstacles may include those described in the In-Hand Trail.

### **Ranch Rail Pleasure**

Measures the ability of the horse to be a pleasure to ride, while being used as a means of conveyance from one ranch task to another. The horse should be well-broke, relaxed, quiet, soft, and cadenced at all gaits. Ridden on a relatively loose rein with light contact and without requiring undue restraint. Horse should be responsive to rider & make timely transitions smoothly and correctly; should be soft in the bridle and yield to rider contact. The ideal stock horse should have a natural, levelheaded carriage

### **Ranch Riding**

The horse should reflect versatility, attitude, and movement of a working ranch horse outside the confines of an arena. The horse should be well-trained, relaxed, quiet, soft, and cadenced at all gaits. The ideal ranch horse will travel with forward movement and demonstrate obvious lengthening of stride at extended gaits. The horse is to be ridden with light contact, or on a relatively loose rein, without requiring undue restraint, but not a full drape of reins. Overall manners and responsiveness of the ranch riding horse to make timely transitions in a smooth and correct manner, as well as the quality of the movement are primary. Horse should have a natural head carriage at each gait.

### **Amateur Reining**

A jackpot class with 5 or more entries. Open to amateur riders. No restrictions on previous wins.

### **Open Reining**

A jackpot class with 5 or more riders.

## **2018 RULES & GENERAL INFORMATION**

1. In order to comply with IHA rules, age status is determined as of December 1st of the previous year. Youth riders are 17 years of age or under; Adult riders are 18 years of age and over as of December 1st
2. Riders will be notified of their advancement to a higher division. A rider may voluntarily advance to a higher division; however, they may not return to a lower division at any time in the future
3. All of the classes being offered will be conducted and run in accordance with the IHA Rules and Regulations, and the 2018 AQHA Rule Book unless otherwise specified. IHA rules supersede any other rules. Should a question or dispute arise that is not covered in the rulebook, the judges' and show management decisions will be final. A protest, in writing, must be lodged the day of the event to the show manager or committee chairperson. All decisions by said person will be final and protests will be answered in writing if necessary
4. Pre-entries will be accepted by phone or e-mail until 9:00 PM the Thursday before the show. All other forms of entry, such as mail, are the responsibility of the entrant and must be received by the Thursday deadline. When a horse show extends the courtesy of taking an advanced entry over the phone, it is with the understanding that said entries will be paid and credit is extended on these terms. No exhibitor will be permitted to perform without payment of fees. A \$25 handling fee will be assessed for any returned checks. All checks are made payable to ***Islip Horseman's Association, Inc.*** A signature for all riders, including those of the guardian of junior exhibitors, will be required
5. No refunds will be issued unless a licensed Vet's diagnosis of the horse's unsoundness, or a Doctor's note of the rider's inability to perform are submitted. If your horse is unable to perform and there is a valid Veterinary note, you will be allowed the use of another horse under the same number and will be eligible for EOY awards. You may revert to your original horse if he becomes fit or continue with the second horse, but there may be no other changes. There will be no refunds offered beyond ten days of the show date. **NOTE:** There may be no substitutions in Halter
6. All participants and spectators enter premises and ride at their own risk. IHA and Suffolk County Department of Parks disclaim any liability for any accident or occurrence no matter what the cause.
7. Absolutely no stallions will be permitted in competition within the IHA at any time. In addition, due to the dangerous nature of stallions in close proximity to other horses, they are not permitted on the show grounds or area, while the IHA is competing

## **(General Cont'd)**

8. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, or divide any class. Classes with less than three riders may be combined. Classes with less than three (3) riders may be held, but no points will be awarded for that class. If cancelled, money will be refunded. All class entries will be closed when the preceding class enters the show ring. A two-minute rule to enter the ring will be strictly enforced. **\*\*\*It is the riders responsibility to be ready for their class\*\*\***
9. Correct mandatory western attire is required: long-sleeved western shirt, hat, boots; chaps are recommended, but not required. Riders under the age of 18 must wear an ASTM approved safety helmet at all times when mounted (NYS law).
10. Proper tack is mandatory. Horses 5-years-old and younger may be shown in a AQHA-approved snaffle bit, curb (shank) bit, or bosal. Horses 6-years-old and older may only be shown in an AQHA-approved curb (shank) bit. When a curb bit is used, a curb strap, or curb chain is required, but must meet the approval of the judge, be at least one-half (1/2") inch in width and lie flat against the jaw of the horse. Curb chains cannot be tied to the bit with string or cord. A broken strap or chain is not necessarily cause for disqualification. Riders must ride one-handed with any kind of shank/curb bit
11. First through sixth place ribbons will be awarded in each class, except reining. Reining will receive a payout at the end of each class. Champion and Reserve will receive an award in each division at the end of the day.
