IHA Western Pleasure Series Reining (Beginner/Amateur)

REINING PATTERN 2

Show Date: 06-23-2024 Beginners may do simple or flying lead changes

Horses may walk or jog to the center of arena. Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern. Beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

- Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
- 2. Complete three circles to the left: the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
- Continue around previous circle to the right. At the top of the circle, run down the middle to the far end of the arena past the end marker and do a right rollback—no hesitation.
- 4. Run up the middle to the opposite end of the arena past the end marker and do a left rollback—no hesitation.
- 5. Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Back up to the center of the arena or at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate.
- 6. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
- 7. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate to demonstrate the completion of the pattern.





- I. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
- 2. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate.
- 3. Beginning on the left lead, complete three circles to the left: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
- 4. Complete three circles to the right: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
- 5. Begin a large circle to the left but do not close this circle. Run up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a right rollback at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence-no hesitation.
- 6. Continue back around previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the left side of the arena past the center marker and do a left rollback at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence-no hesitation.
- 7. Continue back around previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence. Back up at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate to demonstrate the completion of the pattern.

- 5. 360 TURN LEFT
- 6. EXT. TROT
- 7. WALK over RAILS
- 8. STOP & BACK 1 Horse Length, EXIT at a walk





- 1. Begin serpentine at a walk
- 2. Jog at 2^{nd} cone into chute
- 3. Back through chute
- 4. Perform 90° turn to the RIGHT
- 5. Jog to poles
- 6. Walk over poles, bridge & poles
- 7. Jog to box, stop, walk in
- 8. Turn 360° either way
- 9. Walk out of box to finish pattern



- 8. Walk out of box, jog to finish pattern



Walk

- 1. Work Gate, Left Hand
- 2. Jog Serpentine
- 3. Lope Over Poles. Stop
- 4. Extended Jog over poles, break to a walk
- 5. Walk over poles, bridge & poles
- 6. Jog poles, into box
- 7. Stop in box, perform a 360 turn in either direction
- 8. Walk out of box to exit




5- Stop & Sidepass log left

6- Back into chute, trot to bridge

- 7- Walk over bridge to gate
- 8- Work gate to the right. Exit

- 2. Extended trot over log
- 3. Lope left lead over logs

- 7. Walk out of chute and over log and bridge to drag
- 8. Drag log left circle around cone at a walk
- 9. Work gate right hand; exit at walt to finish pattern
