2024 GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. All classes being offered herein will be conducted and run in accordance with the Islip Horsemen's Association rules and regulations and the current USEF Rule Book unless otherwise specified. IHA rules will be available for reference.
- 2. Pre-entries will be accepted online at *Horseshowing.com*, or by phone until 9:00 PM the Thursday preceding the show date. Mailed entries, regular or E-mailed, are the responsibilities of the entrant and must be received by the above deadline. No one will be permitted to perform without payment of all fees. All exhibitors must sign a release form and a parent/ quardian's signature is required for all Junior riders.
- 3. After closing dates there will be no refunds without a licensed Veterinarian's Certificate of the horse's unsoundness or a Doctor's note of the rider's inability to perform. Notes are to be submitted to the show committee within 10 days. There are no horse substitutions permitted in Hunters or Jumpers.
- 4. Show starts promptly at 9AM. In the event of class cancellation, refunds will be made by mail.
- 5. Proper English attire is required in all classes. An ASTM/SEI approved helmet must be worn by all mounted riders. Half chaps not permitted. No refunds will be given for incorrect attire.
- 6. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, divide or move any class. Classes with less than 3 entries may be combined or cancelled. **Division split requests will not be honored.**
- 7. When filling a division, the rider must pay for said division in order for their points to count.
- 8.All participants and spectators enter premises and ride at their own risk. IHA, Suffolk County, and or the show committee disclaim liability for any accident or occurrence, no matter what the cause.
- 9. Schooling will be permitted on the jumping courses from 7:30 to 8:45 AM and during lunch breaks as follows, 6 riders at a time for once around the course.
- 10. A rider's age will be determined as of the previous December 1.
- 11. Division eligibility of the rider at first show shall remain the same for the entire season. An IHA show season consists of any or all IHA shows within a calendar year commencing January 1 and ending December 31.
- 12. If a trainer enters the ring with an entrant, the entrant will be disqualified. Verbal assistance is also cause for disqualification. This includes coaching from the sidelines, shouting directions, and/or course instruction to riders during the class. No one may approach a judge at any time without permission from the ring steward.
- 13. Martingales are not permitted in any flat classes. Flashes will not be permitted in equitation or hunters. Boots, bandages or wraps are not permitted in Hunter divisions. Black stirrups are not allowed in equitation classes. See IHA rule book for more details.
- 14. A two-minute rule to enter the ring will be strictly enforced. Trainer conflicts will not be honored. There will be a 10-minute time limit enforced on holding a class due to rider/horse conflicts.
- 15. Classes with less than 3 riders will not be eligible for year end awards.

The Bohemia Equestrian Center is located on Sycamore Avenue, 1/4 mile south of Veterans Hwy and 2 miles north of Sunrise Hwy. in Bohemia. It is on the N.E. corner of Connetquot park.

- 16. A1st place trophy and six ribbons will be awarded in all classes. Grand ribbon and Trophy and Reserve ribbon will be awarded in each division. EOD Junior and Adult Grand and Reserve Champion ribbons will be awarded to the high point horse and rider of the day.
- 17. Should a question or dispute arise that is not provided for in the rules, the same shall be put in writing the day of the show and referred to the show management, whose decision shall be final.
- 18. Trainers may not ride in equitation divisions. Amateur Eligibility Rule: To those who have not received payment to show, judge, train, or assist in training a horse whether monetary or otherwise, either directly or indirectly, (with the exception of therapeutic trainers) nor received payment whether monetary or otherwise for instructing a person in riding, driving, training or showing a horse for 5 calendar years prior to application for amateur membership, regardless of discipline.
- 19. Riders who ride in Novice or Open classes in any other discipline are not eligible to ride in IHA English Beginner classes.
- 20. If taken off show ground by ambulance, you may not return that day to resume participation in the show.



The Northeast Equestrian Series (NES) is a schooling show series located on Long Island. The series is founded on the principle of bringing the local horse community together through safe competition, comradery, and horse/rider development. The horse show divisions are hosted at the following equestrian facilities; IHA, Hidden Pond Stables, Hillcrest, DDR, Old Field Farm and Country Farms. All registered participants in Northeast Equestrian Series divisions are eligible to compete at the NES Finals held at Old Field Farm each fall. NES riders and horses are also eligible for yearend awards based on the accumulation of points throughout the show season. The celebration of the horses, riders and awards is held during the Annual Northeast Equestrian Series Banquet.

IHA DIVISION AWARDS

To be eligible for IHA Year End Division Awards, the rider must be an IHA member by the conclusion of the first show entered. Exhibitors must amass a minimum of 10 points and attend two of the three English shows and compete in two of the three classes in the division to qualify for year end division awards. See IHA Rules and Regulations for further information on Year End Awards. End of year ribbons awarded up to sixth place. In case of conflicts with year end awards, the resolution will be decided by the English Committee.





Trainers will specify one division in three of these four categories: Equitation, Hunter, Pleasure and/or Jumpers. Then they will choose which rider in each who will represent them prior to the start of the show. The same rider may be selected for any or all of the divisions. All points accumulated by the specified rider or riders in the specified divisions will be tallied over the season for the Trainer Series Award. Participating trainers must be IHA members.

PLEASURE DIVISION

Points awarded to horse regardless of rider.

PLEASURE: Open to All except those entered in Beginner or Cross-rail Hunter classes.

46. Pleasure: Walk, Trot, Canter with light contact. **47. Bridle Path Hack:** Walk, Trot Canter. May be required to hand gallop and halt.

48. Pleasure: Walk, Trot, Canter. To jump 2 cross rails,

trotting permitted.

Unsportsmanlike Conduct; Inhumane Treatment of Animals

Conduct by judges, IHA members and non-members, volunteers, exhibitors, trainers, owners (and/or their representatives), spectators and all other persons present on the show grounds or in show facilities shall be orderly, responsible, sportsmanlike, courteous and respectful. No one on the show grounds or during any event associated with IHA shall engage in misconduct that is irresponsible, illegal, indecent, profane, intimidating (including but not limited to bullying, either verbally or physically), threatening or abusive misconduct, nor emotional misconduct, which includes but is not limited to verbal acts, such as verbal assault that repeatedly attacks someone personally or repeatedly and excessively yelling at any person in a manner that serves no productive training or motivational purpose. Any and all direct abusive and threatening conduct while on the show grounds will not be tolerated. Anyone witnessing such misconduct shall immediately report the act(s) to a committee person at the time of the incident, and the offending person (s) will be issued a warning as to their behavior. If the conduct persists, the offending person(s) will be directed to leave the show grounds in order to preserve the decorum of the show.

JUMPER DIVISIONS Points awarded to horse regardless of rider.

HOPSCOTCH JUMPER: Open to Juniors and Amateurs who have not cross-entered into any classes where jump height exceeds 2'. Jump height is X-rails at 18"

The same rider may not win more than 2 consecutive years in a row. Should this occur, the saddle will be awarded to the rider with the second highest number of points. The high-point rider will remain the same.





Practices are held at the Bohemia Equestrian Center on Sycamore Avenue in Bohemia on Wednesdays, 5:45 pm to 7:15 pm.




