IHA DRESSAGE SEAT EQUITATION VIRTUAL SHOW PRIZE LIST

Dressage seat equitation is a **relatively new class offered at dressage shows**. Unlike a dressage test, the horse's gaits are not judged, although the horse's frame is taken into consideration by the judge, but rather it is the rider who is evaluated.

Open to IHA Members Only

Open to Adult Amateur and Junior English & Western Riders

Open to Trainers who may Enter the Open Division only

Divisions: English; Western and Open. If entries warrant, we will split English & Western classes into Adult and Junior Divisions.

Show Instructions:

1. Submit a completed entry form with payment by email or mail.

2. Video your test following the "Video Guidelines" below, a separate video for each test

3. Upload your video(s) to YouTube

4. Post a comment with the YouTube link to your video (ride) on the appropriate class on the entry form. Be sure to add your name, your horse's name, division and class #.

5. Entry closing date is July 16, 2020. Video submissions open on July 17 and close midnight of July 24.

6. The judge will have a week after the show date, July 25, to score the rides, followed by the processing of scores. The results will be emailed to each competitor with scores. Placings for each division will posted on the IHA website, the Dressage page and on the IHA Dressage FB page no later August 3.

Video Guidelines:

1. Videos must be in landscape (horizontal) view

- 2. Use a tripod or steady surface to keep the video as steady as possible
- 3. Film from "C" the judge's position, approx 10 ft back from edge of arena & 2 ft up if possible

4. Arena - the perimeter needs to be marked, at least in part, on all four sides; **corners HAVE to be marked**; minimum size is a small arena which is 20x40m; arena can be DIY, it does not have to be fancy

5. Arena letters (markers) have to be visible, they can be DIY

- 6. Keep the entire horse/rider from hoof to helmet in view at all times
- 7. Zoom in as the horse/rider are further away
- 8. The test must be ridden from beginning to end, no editing or cutting of videos
- 9. Upload at the highest resolution possible with a minimum of 480

Note: The judge reserves the right to decline any video due to poor quality. Please review your video for clarity and appropriate lighting prior to submission. If needed, a request for new video footage will be sent to the competitor's email address.

Rules & General Information:

Entries: Open to IHA members in good standing in 2020; Adult Amateur and Junior riders only. No trainers. Mail/Email entries to IHA Dressage Show, Angela Pecora, 919 Sycamore Avenue, Bohemia NY 11716-3516, email to <u>ihadressage@yahoo.com</u>. Payments accepted via check or PayPal (friends and family preferred) and must accompany entry forms. Entry forms will be accepted on a first come, first served basis with a limited number of rides available. Show management reserves the right to refuse any entry.

Show Timing & Results: Entry closing date is **July 16**. No video will be reviewed if a completed and paid entry is not received by July 16. Videos may begin to be uploaded to YouTube beginning **July 17** and must be posted on YouTube by **July 24** at midnight. The Judge will have one week to score each test. Results of the scoring should be completed within 3-4 days of receiving tests back from judge. Then the test results will be emailed to each competitor no later than August 3, 2020. Placings will be posted on the IHA Dressage page and on the IHA Dressage Facebook page by August 4.

Scratches & Cancellations: Scratches made prior to the closing date will be refunded. *No refunds or credits will be made after the closing date for any reason.*

Awards: First place: Entry fee waived for *two* classes of choice in *one* of the 2021 IHA Dressage Schooling shows.

USEF rules will be followed regarding tack, headgear, etc.

Attire & Grooming: Riders and horses must be neat and presentable. We encourage the use of helmets while riding. Suitable footwear with a heel should be worn for safety reasons. Horses do not need to be braided and extra points will not be awarded for those horses that are braided.






Canter on diagonal, change leads through trot on centerline.






Easy and Short No. 2:

Working trot on centerline, at X figure 8 with 10 meter circles






Easy and Short No. 3:


On centerline at working trot, pick up lead directed by judge at X

Three loop serpentine at trot, width of arena






Canter 3 loop serpentine, width of arena, changing leads through trot on centerline






Medium and Short No. 2:


Leg yield at working trot, changing from leg yield right to leg yield left, or vice versa once (specify letters for start and finish of each leg yield
