- Due to virus safety concerns and restrictions, the board approved the cancellation of this year's 4th of July parade.
- After consultation with the LLPHOA attorney, David Braun, the board approved the adoption of a \$100.00 Estoppel fee.
 Implementation of the fee will begin on June 8th, 2020.
- The board discussed hiring a DJ for the Oktoberfest/Fall Festival and possible event dates on Oct 24th or Nov 7th. However, after debate over virus concerns, safety and financial considerations, the board approved the cancellation of this year's Oktoberfest/Fall Festival.
- On June 7th 2020, Teri C., Don D., Judy Black, and Carol Noyes started the process of counting and recording the LLPHOA covenant revision ballots. The process was done at Teri C.'s residence, and a total of 97 ballots were counted. Storage of all ballots remains at Teri C.'s home.

- Due to virus safety concerns and restrictions, Don D. advised the deadline for the 1081 Torchwood Dr. appeal's process has been extended to Wed. July 15th 2020. Depending on the virus situation, further extension of the deadline may be required.
