Booking requests must be completed at least 5 business days in advance, online at service.london.ca or by phone at 519-661-2489. Collection will occur on your next scheduled garbage day. Large items are over 1 metre wide, 1.5 metres tall and require 2 or more people to safely place at the curb. There is a four item limit per collection.

- 1 pound of ground beef
- 1 pound of ground pork
- 1 tbsp of Worcestershire sauce
- 1 box of stove top chicken stuffing mix
- 1/4 cup of HP sauce
- 1/4 cup of ketchup
- 4 tbsp of brown sugar
- Preheat oven to 375 degrees.
- -Combine ground meat, Worcestershire sauce and stuffing mix. Form into loaf or place into loaf pan
- -In a bowl combine ketchup, HP sauce and brown sugar, spread over meatloaf.
- Cover with tinfoil, bake in oven for 45 to 60 mins (depending on your desired doneness) remove tinfoil last 20 mins of cook time.
- -Remove from oven and let rest for 10 minutes

Serve with mashed potatoes and fresh veg! Green beans go well

*A fun take on this is meatloaf muffins! Prepare as above but fill muffin cups with meatloaf mixture and sauce topping. Cut bake time to 30 minutes. While meat cuppies are baking, prepare mashed potato "frosting" and frost meatloaf cupcakes once they are out of the oven. Top that with some green onion garnish or cheddar cheese sprinkles.

This is especially fun for picky eaters! Enjoy!
