1. Camera Basics (4 Private lessons – 90 minutes each)

Schedule your lessons at your convenience and learn at your own pace!

With my **“Camera Basics”** course you will quickly learn how to control your settings and capture what *you* visualize. Through demonstrations and in-class exercises, you will learn how to capture impressive images using the three creative modes on your camera: manual mode as well as the aperture and shutter priority modes.

What to bring: Your camera with printed manual, fully charged batteries, and a card with memory to spare. Tripod and external flash great but optional.

Method: Discussion, demonstration, shooting exercises (indoor/outdoor), assignments

2. **Camera basics PLUS (8 group lessons – 2 hours each)**

Small groups of up to 6 students will ensure lots of individual attention plus lots of interaction opportunities.

Who should attend: This course is especially designed for students who want to learn from the beginning.

What you will learn: We begin with learning how to use the three creative modes. i.e. the Manual mode as well as the Shutter Priority and the Aperture Priority modes. We move on to lessons on landscape, action, macro and portrait photography. Composition and lighting techniques will also be included with each topic. We finish with a demo on Photoshop Elements and some basic editing tools.

Method: Demonstrations, in-class exercises, several assignments and one field trip.

What to bring: Your camera with printed manual, fully charged batteries. Tripod/flash optional.

3. Portrait Photography (8 group lessons – 2 hours each)

Small groups of up to 6 students will ensure lots of individual attention.

Portrait Photography Workshop: Learn how to observe, pose and light individuals and get flattering portraits.

Who should attend: You should already have a BASIC understanding of your camera i.e. how to load card, download images, and access the menu or if you have completed Camera Basics

What you will learn: Techniques on how to use ambient light indoors and outdoors; direct vs. diffused lighting; how to use reflectors; effective use of built-in and add-on flashes (direct, bounced) and demo on multiple flashes. Students will be encouraged to practice during class and some assignments will be given. Composition for individuals, couples and groups will also be covered.

What to bring: Your camera with printed manual, fully charged batteries, and a card.

Add-on flash important. Tripod optional.
