About You:

You are reliable, accepting, and welcoming to all young people who walk through the doors. You are capable of maintaining building safety by holding young people accountable to community norms in the building.

Some Specifics:

- You will be available for general academic support during open door hours
- You will help facilitate study groups or specialized tutoring as needed
- You will work with your supervisor to develop academic plans for students who are requesting it
- You will help provide general supervision of the study/recreation area during open door hours
- You will assist with general tidiness and organization of MTN areas (restocking fridges, snacks, taking out garbages)
- You will see young people. You will learn their names, practice intentional listening, encourage their learning journey, and cheerlead them on!
- You will engage young people by playing games with them, hanging out in the study area, offering snacks, etc.
- You will join an all staff meeting once per month, a quarterly training, and shared learning sessions as they arise
- You will conduct other duties as assigned

Additional Opportunities (optional):

- You will assist checking young people in and reviewing community norms when they enter MTN
- You will help support youth event nights and structured activities
- You will answer phone calls and give building tours to young people
