New Business

Cancellations and no-shows

Carol discussed the need to review our policy as the number of last minute cancellations and no-shows is increasing. Chris (WGC GM) has shared the policy in place at Los Verdes (his former GM assignment) that assessed the club greens fees for no-shows/last minute cancellations. It is WWGA's hope that by addressing this issue ourselves we will avoid forcing the issue with WGC management. It was agreed to begin enforcement of the existing WWGA policy (adopted January 2019 – but sporadically enforced).

Cancellations on Monday or Tuesday, and no-shows:

- 1st – free pass
- 2nd – warning
- 3rd - \$5 fine assessed

There was some discussion on the leniency of this plan. The board will review and provide detail on implementation / enforcement responsibilities.

Helen's Room

Carol Earle shared the board's decision to remove an annual donation to Helen's Room from the budget. The minutes from the January board meeting:

- Charity/Donations was removed from the budget. It was agreed that as a Recreational Amateur Women's Golf club dues collected are designated for the pursuit of golf and related social activities for its members. The board does not have the authority to allocate monies (dues) paid by members for these purposes to a philanthropic cause. Having agreed on this, the board also agreed that Helen's Room is a worthy and popular cause among membership. It was agreed that throughout the year there would be events planned to raise money for Helen's Room using contributions from membership. The expectation is that total funds would likely be greater than budgeted contributions in prior years. Examples: 50/50 pot at meetings be allocated, a weekly game where there is a member buy-in with proceeds going to Helen's Room, Fundraisers at luncheons (outright collection and/or raffle).

Naomi Jones shared information on the history of Helen's room. She reiterated that over the years many of our WWGA members have had a cancer diagnosis, and this is a cause that impacts all of us in some way. She also reminded us that 100% of donations go to client services.

Gondo Classic

Barb Hornak announced the upcoming Gondo Classic golf tournament, scramble format, on June 17 at Sunset Hills Golf Club. This year the Tournament is honoring the memory of our long-time member Myra Einberg. Barb encouraged WWGA members to participate. For those members unable to participate there are opportunities to support the event through raffle/auction and donations. (flyer attached)

Following these rules enhances pace of play because you are not delaying the group behind you by walking around the green after you putt out.
