The stated meeting of the Madison Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairman Rhonda Stitz at 7:00 p.m. Also attending the meeting were Supervisors Larry Hartzell and Mark Shellenberger.

Fuel Bids:

Phone bid; Fruit Fuel \$.20 over rack price with additive. Leighow Oil \$.16.5 over rack price, and \$.19.5 over rack with additive. **Motion** by Larry Hartzell, second by Mark Shellenberger, to accept Leighow Oil bid. Motion carried.

The minutes of the Organization meeting held January 5, 2026, and the regular meeting held January 13, 2026, were accepted and approved. **Motion** by Mark Shellenberger, second by Larry Hartzell. Motion carried

The Treasurer's report that includes the check register and the Profit & Loss reports were accepted and approved. **Motion** by Rhonda Stitz, second by Larry Hartzell. Motion carried

Reports:

Police: Officer Charles Dietterick presented report

Municipal Authority: No meeting

Planning Commission: Rhonda Stitz reported that we have a sewage module to review under new business.

Road Master: Plowing snow, cindering, Stryker has been hauling us cinders from York. We have received 15 loads. Fixed Magee Road. Doing truck maintenance. Plow broke and replaced with new plow. The road crew has worked almost every weekend for two months.

Dean Seidel reported on behalf of the Millville Fire Company and the fire companies (approx. 15) that helped fight the house fire on Katy's Church Road. Thank you to Larry Hartzell and the road crew for having the road well maintained and in good condition.

Old Business:

A 90-day extension will be necessary to give the solicitor time to review the Taylor Road Solar Project plan. **Motion** by Rhonda Stitz to request the 90-day extension; Larry Hartzell seconded. Motion carried.

New Business:

Beiler sewage module – Jonas M. and Bertha Beiler have proposed a subdivision on Shultz Road. **Motion** to approve sewage module by Larry Hartzell, seconded by Mark Shellenberger. Motion carried.

Taylor Road Project – Madison Township has been approved for a Dirt & Gravel grant for the second half of Taylor Road. **Motion** to advertise for bids by Larry Hartzell, seconded by Rhonda Stitz. Motion carried.

New Truck – Purchase of new 2026 Freightliner from Sherwood Trucks for \$245,306. Madison Township and Sherwood Trucks both participate in Costars, so it will not be necessary to go through the bid process to purchase the truck. **Motion** by Rhonda Stitz, second by Larry Hartzell to purchase the truck. Motion carried.

New Plow – As mentioned during the Roadmaster report, one of our plows broke beyond repair. It was necessary to replace the broken plow. **Motion** – by Rhonda Stitz, seconded by Mark Shellenberger to approve the purchase of a Flink 11 plow from Bradco Supply Company for \$17,465. Bradco participates in Costars, so it was not necessary to go through the bid process. Motion carried.
