1. Where do you live? Have your child, on their own or with your help, identify the following questions: (using worksheet #1)
 - a. In what country do you live?
 - b. In what state do you live?
 - c. In what city do you live?
 - d. In what neighborhood do you live?
 - e. What is your address, telephone number, zip code? All of this information is SUPER important for your kiddo to know. Making a rhyme or a game out of it is a super helpful memory tool.
 - i. What are Mommy and Daddy's first and last names?
 - ii. What is mommy or daddy's phone number?
2. What structures to people live in?
 - a. Houses, townhomes, condos, apartments, etc.
 - b. What makes where you live your home? Family, pets, love, treasured possessions - i.e. lovelies
 - c. This is a great time to do a neighborhood walk. If that isn't possible, using google maps, look at different views of different neighborhoods.
 - d. What type of dwellings are there? House, apartment, condo, townhome
 - e. How many floors/rooms/bedrooms/bathrooms do different structures have?
 - f. What kind of neighborhood would you like to live in?
 - i. One with a park
 - ii. Close to grocery stores
 - iii. Close to restaurants
 - iv. Lots of open space
 - v. Close to theaters and museums
 - vi. One that is walker friendly
 - vii. One with no neighbors, or one with a lot of neighbors
